Data Storage Task

Using a device:

- 1. Take a series of selfies and remember how many you took.
- 2. Find your selfies on your device. Did you see all of the selfies you took? If you are on a mobile device, have you tried searching for "selfie" in your photo album app?
- 3. Open and edit **one** of the selfies you took in some way: crop, recolor, etc.
- 4. Delete any selfies that you don't like. Don't delete them all.
- 5. Find your selfies again. Are the ones you deleted gone from what you find?

Reflection Task

- How many different pieces of data you created
- How many different pieces of data you saw when you found your selfies on your device before you deleted any and how many after you deleted the ones you didn't like.
