Emergency Preparedness Policy

At Greenhills Camp, we take emergency preparedness very seriously. We understand that unexpected situations can arise and we want to ensure that we are well-prepared to handle any emergency that may occur. Our emergency preparedness policy includes the following measures:

1. **Emergency Response Plan:** We have an emergency response plan in place that outlines procedures for various types of emergencies, including severe weather, fires, medical emergencies, and other incidents. The plan is reviewed and updated regularly to ensure it remains current and effective.
2. **Staff Training:** All staff members are notified on the emergency response plan and their specific roles and responsibilities in case of an emergency.
3. **Communication:** We have clear communication protocols in place, including a chain of command for decision-making and a system for quickly communicating emergency information to all staff members

and campers. It is up to the parents to have Colm's number saved in their phone in case of an emergency.

4. Evacuation Procedures: We have evacuation procedures in place for various types of emergencies, including designated meeting points.

5. First Aid and Medical Care: We have staff trained in basic first aid. We also have a protocol in place for transporting campers to the nearest hospital or medical facility if needed.

6. Emergency Supplies: We maintain an inventory of emergency supplies, including first aid kits, water, food, and other essential items.

By implementing these measures, we are able to ensure the safety and well-being of our campers and staff in the event of an emergency. Our emergency preparedness policy is designed to minimise risk and ensure that we are well-prepared to handle any situation that may arise.
