

Republic Services & Covington City

Contract

INFORMATION:

It is with great honor to announce that Republic Services & Covington City Mayor have reached terms to start business within the city. Listed below is the agreement agreed upon both sides for collection service within Covington city.

-This contract is on a renewal base. This contract is set to renew on 2.1.2020, if there are no objections.

-Covington City will have several locations that any players can dump items in (trash cans) that do not need anymore. Republic Services will be responsible for collecting the items and taking them to one of their transfer stations and sort items that can be reused, items that are deemed unnecessary and not needed by workers will be left to despawn.

-Republic Services will set up times when trash is collected from the stations. Republic Services will try to not leave a station full for more than 48 hours. Though multiple cans may be put in place to reduce the times of pickups.

-Covington City government will be responsible for paying the bill each month. The current bill is set at \$550 (at the time of signing contract). Republic Services reserves the right to change this amount after payment of last bill. Republic Services may not raise the bill more than \$450 from the last set bill and may not raise it more after the previous raise. Republic Services may decrease the bill at any rate. Republic Services will notify the Mayor of Covington City of any changes AT LEAST 2 days after payment of last bill. Republic Services will state the reason for the price change as well. The payment system will run off a prepaid system (Meaning the charge will be for the following month of service.)

-If Covington City fails to pay its bill on the due date, late fees will be added onto the bill. The late fee will consist of \$30 each day it is not paid, the late fee will be added onto the bill. If 5 days go past without payment, Republic Services will discontinue services. On the 7th day of no payment, a lawsuit can be put in place by Republic Services. After the 7th day of no payment, late fees will stop occurring.

-Covington City has agreed to provide a transfer station for Republic Services, at no cost.

-Republic Services will maintain all plots of dumping areas & transfer stations at completion of build.

-Covington City has the right to opt out of this contract at anytime. A fee will be charged for opting out of the contract, the fee will consist of \$850 (Will not change.) Republic Services will keep ownership dumping areas and transfer stations given to them.

-All items put in the trash cans owned and operated by Republic Services, are now property of Republic Services.

-Any further arguments to be added to the contract will be done so, if needed and agreed on.
