You will be expected **DAILY** to:

A) Attend

- a) IF ABSENT, there will be an absence folder on Canvas to pull up what was missed, by date

B) Check Canvas (kutztown.instructure.com)

- a) All lessons and assignments posted here
 - i) The **first module of the year** will provide **how-to's and explanations** of the technology and anything else required
 - (1) Each module will be listed by week and/or unit
 - (a) The new modules will be posted by Monday morning at 7 am.
 - (2) The first lesson in each module will provide an overview of the entire week
 - (3) All assignments will be turned in through Canvas
 - (a) Videos, responses, online activities, notes, discussions, and labs
 - (b) Assignments should take no longer than an additional 20 minutes per night per class
 - (c) 2-3 assignments per week; no tests, but quizzes and projects will occur
 - (i) Will be graded
 - (ii) Must be completed ON TIME
 - (4) Absence folder module
 - (a) Contains any necessary components missed from class daily
 - (i) You're responsible for making up all missed work!

1. Each day missed provides one-day for make-up.
