1.2 Holiday Observance

Holidays that fall on a Saturday will be observed on the preceding Friday.
Holidays that fall on a Sunday will be observed on the following Monday.

1.3 Holiday Schedules. Hourly ESE's who are required to work on a day observed as a holiday will be compensated at one and one-half (1.5) times their regularly hourly rate for all such hours. With approval of the supervisor, an ESE may be permitted to work additional hours during a holiday week to avoid a loss of paid hours.
