

Story Sequencing

Instructions

- 1. Sequencing is when you put things in order of when they should happen
- 2. This is a story that is all out of order. Can you decide what order these things happen in? Put all of the events in order! (The answers are on the next page. No Cheating!)
- A. Alex takes care of the lost puppy. Alex plays with the puppy and gives it food. Max decides to name the puppy Buddy
- B. Max knows that someone might be missing Buddy, so he posts fliers all around his neighborhood to tell everyone that Buddy is ok and to call Max and his mom if Buddy is their dog

- C. Max is playing in his backyard when he hears a rustle from behind a bush. When he goes to see what it is, he finds a small lost puppy
- D. Alex and his mom take Buddy to a park to meet his owner. His owner is very happy to see Buddy again! He gives Alex a small toy to thank him for bringing Buddy back!
- E. Alex's mom gets a call from Buddy's owner! They set up a time to meet at a park and give Buddy back to his owner

The answer is that C comes first, then A, then B, after that is E, last is D C, A, B, E, D $\,$
