Reading Literary Text (SLA.1)

- Analyze how themes emerge through character interactions and poetic form.
- Summarize objectively, citing evidence across authentic Spanish texts (Interpretive).
- Compare structure and style across genres, with emphasis on authentic poetry from Spanish-speaking authors.
- Explore connections to AP Spanish theme Beauty & Aesthetics through poetry's cultural expression.

Reading Informational Text (SLA.2)

- Identify and analyze central ideas in informational Spanish texts.
- Evaluate structure, argument, and point of view in texts tied to AP Spanish themes such as Global Challenges or Families & Communities.
- Compare perspectives across sources to deepen intercultural competence.

Reading Vocabulary (SLA.3)

- Interpret figurative language, idioms, and regional variations in Spanish.
- Expand academic vocabulary for argumentative and informative writing.

Written Expression (Using both Literary and Informational prompts) (SLA.5)

- Write argumentative essays with clear claims supported by evidence (Presentational).
- Develop informative/explanatory writing that integrates researched details.
- Craft narratives that explore identity and culture, connecting to AP Spanish theme Personal & Public Identities.

Knowledge of Written Language and Conventions (SLA.6)

- Apply Spanish grammar, syntax, and conventions for clarity.
- Revise drafts to strengthen cohesion and precision.
