Oasis Kids Relaunch (When Manatee Co Schools reopen) Aug 23rd



## 1. Facility Safety & Procedures:

### Traffic Flow/Social Distancing Precautions

1. Follow all posted directional signs and arrows.
2. As you enter the main doors (that are propped open), take a left to enter the auditorium. Center auditorium doors will be closed.
3. As you enter the auditorium, an Oasis team member will greet you, find out how many people are with you, then bring you to your seats.
4. We are at 50% capacity. We are taking up every other row and having a three chairs space between families.
5. When service is over, everyone will be asked to exit through the back to doors of the auditorium.
6. We encourage conversations outside, as we clean the building.
7. If there are no more seats available, feel free to watch online in your car, listen to the service on your car radio or you can wait for the second service.
8. Playground will be open.

### Cleaning/Sanitations

1. There will be several spots for you to use hand sanitizer thought-out the building
2. There will be hand sanitizer outside of the restrooms.
3. An Oasis team member will be sanitizing surfaces in the lobby thought-out the service consistently.
4. There will be sanitizing supplies in each bathroom stall to be used as needed.
5. There will be an Oasis team member sanitizing bathroom doors/sinks/counters every 15 mins.
6. We will be sanitizing the seats before each service with fabric sanitizer.



### Contactless Service

1. No Coffee.
2. No snacks.
3. No Bulletins.
4. No water cups, unless you bring your own. (Water fountains can be used to refill containers but not to use your mouth on)
5. Offering being dropped in a bucket as you leave service.
6. Doors will be propped open.



## 2. Oasis Kids

ALL AGES WILL BEGIN WHEN MANATEE COUNTY SCHOOLS REOPEN

SUNDAY AUGUST 23RD AS OF RIGHT NOW.

Nursery: Each classroom will be limited to 8 children per room with 2 adults for ages 1-2yrs

Nursery: Unless a parent is serving we will not be accepting children under 12 months.

1 small group leader for no more than 9 students for ages 3-11 (there are cameras in every classroom and the doors will be as open as possible to allow accountability)..

Volunteers will be wearing masks and will wash their hands in between transition points.

Children will have their temperature taken before entering a classroom and it must be below 100.4 (per CDC guidelines). Children cannot be showing any obvious signs of illness.

Anyone entering a classroom will wash their hands.

The classrooms will be cleaned in between services with a DCF (Department of Children and Families) approved bleach and water mixture (a very small amount of bleach is used in this mixture and will have time to evaporate before kids reenter the room).

Families with more than one student in a similar age range will have siblings together in one group to avoid exposure to multiple groups of children.

Families will be spaced 6ft apart during pick up and drop off.

Masks are optional for children. Masks are not recommended for children 2 and under.

Activities will be aimed to encourage social distance while still allowing kids to connect.

All ages are welcome to attend adult service if you are not yet comfortable with them attending children's service.



### Oasis Kids Small groups ages 3+

We will be using a montessori style environment for the next 3 months to keep siblings together and limit exposure to multiple families (Montessori is the mixing of age ranges so the younger students can learn from their peers and older classmates)

We will rotate groups through stations so they will each get to go to a craft room, scripture verse room, snack room, outside play, and bible lesson and worship. Each station will be cleaned between groups and each group will have an activity packet to engage their students without sharing materials.

We will be using this style of service until January. But we will constantly be evaluating safety and efficacy of our services and adjusting as needed. After January our goal will be to return to separating by grade and age unless we deem it too risky.
