

EN-01 Enrollment - Policy (page 1 of 1)

“The belief contained in the Educational Options Policy of the School Board says it well, ‘We believe teachers, students, parents and administrators should choose educational options. Such choices should result in philosophical matches for teachers, students, parents and administrators.’ ” (FD 26)

“The D’Evelyn Program is an extension of the philosophy of Dennison. Dennison will continue to be a main source of student enrollment.” (FD 25)

“Students from the Dennison Fundamental School shall have priority in admission to the High School.” (FD 60)

Enrollment will be determined in accordance with District policy for an option school with Dennison Elementary School as the designated feeder school. (FD 54)

The D’Evelyn education program lays the foundation for advanced high school academic material and relies on sequential mastery of the core subjects. Additionally, graduation requirements stipulate a four year sequence of required core courses. Therefore, new students may be accepted only up to 9th grade.

New students are not required to make up the D’Evelyn coursework from previous grades. However, new students in grades 7-9 with failing grades in five or more semester-long or quarter-long classes from the previous school year will be enrolled at D’Evelyn at their previous grade level.

Returning to D’Evelyn from a leave of absence

Temporary relocation, study abroad programs, or medical needs may force students to temporarily withdraw from D’Evelyn. D’Evelyn seeks to meet family needs within the program parameters. Returning students who meet the requirements of EN-01-R3 will not have to re-enroll through a lottery process.
