CCHS Butch Lee Memorial Soccer Tournament Rules

Dates: Tuesday, December 10 - Saturday December 14, 2024

Locations: Cathedral Catholic HS, Westview HS, Del Norte HS, Mt Carmel HS, University City HS, Bonita Vista HS and Poway HS

Games: Each team is guaranteed 3 games. All games will be 35-minute halves.

Format: 24 teams. 8 brackets of 3 teams. Winner of each bracket advances to quarterfinals. 2nd and 3rd place teams will play their 3rd game on Friday.

Scoring:

- Six (6) points = WIN
- Three (3) points = TIE
- Zero (0) points = LOSS
- One (1) point for each Goal scored up to a maximum of three (3) per game
- One (1) point for each Shutout
- -1 point for each ejection (player/coach)
- A 0-0 tie will be scored as 4 points for each team

Any tie in total points between teams at the end of pool play will be resolved on the following basis:

- 1. The winner in head-to-head competition
- 2. Fewest goals against
- 3. Most goals scored up to a maximum of four (4) per game
- 4. Most wins
- 5. Most shutouts
- 6. Coin Toss

Home team: The home team will be the team whose name appears first for each game on the game schedule. The home team will be required to wear dark jerseys as stated by CIF.

<u>Tie matches:</u> (Quarter-Final, Semi-Final or Championship matches) If a quarter-final, semi-final or championship game ends in a tie at the end of regulation play there will be a single (15) minute overtime with the first team scoring being deemed the winner. If that OT period ends in a tie, a winner will be determined by kicks from the spot. (Penalty kicks)

Shoot-out format: Five (5) players from each team will be selected to take the penalty shots. Any player on the roster may participate in the shoot-out even if she was not playing at the end of regulation. Player's red carded during the game or ineligible to play from a previous red card may not participate. The teams will alternate taking shots. After 5 shots from each team, the team with the most goals will be declared winner. Should the match remain tied, a "sudden death" shoot-out will take place with each team alternating turns until a winner is declared. At least ten (10) different players from each team must take a turn shooting before any player from a team can take a second penalty shot.
