Importance of Relationships

They increase academic achievement.

- Students who feel connected to school are
 - More likely to attend school
 - More likely to stay in school longer
 - More likely to have higher grades and test scores
- Students with feelings of closeness with school staff have been shown to
 - Work harder in school
 - Spend more time on homework
 - Receive better grades
 - Have more confidence in their academic abilities

They decrease high-risk behaviors.

- Less likely to smoke cigarettes
- Less likely to drink alcohol
- Less likely to have sexual intercourse
- Less likely to have emotional problems
- Less likely to experience suicidal thoughts or attempts

They make schools safer.

- Less likely to carry weapons
- Less likely to become involved in violence
- Less likely to be involved in dangerous activities




