- Dress for the weather the seasons are changing. We are having cool mornings that warm up as the sun rises higher in the sky.

Students need to be making use of their learning time in the classroom. Frequent trips to the washroom to change are distracting from important learning. You can refer to the school behavior matrix that was shared with you for an understanding of expected behavior in the washroom.
- School Lunch Program Reminder some new menu choices have been added to the School Lunch Program this year. While families are trying out the new options, we encourage you to be aware that your child may not like the food offered on that day and may need extra food packed in their bag. I am sending information that was distributed last year from the department of education (EECD):

 Please note that the School Lunch Program menu is the only menu offered by the school during lunch period. No additional food items are served during this period. We encourage you to engage with your child about their experiences and

favorite meals, and to involve them in meal selection each cycle. Families are also welcome to continue to pack food from home if they choose.
