Phenomenon: Animals are awesome in many ways.



Question to Investigate: How are animals awesome?



Lesson Objective: Students will draw and write about their awesome animal to communicate and share their work.



Success Criteria: I can share how animals are awesome.



Launch



Let's sing our Awesome Animals song. Awesome Animals by Ms. Pratt



Let's read a story about a young girl who thought animals were awesome. Let's read to find out what Valentina does to show her love for animals.



Endangered means that a species is considered to be facing a high risk of extinction in the wild. These animals only have a small number of animals of its kind left. Extinct means an animal no longer exists. Like the dinosaurs in this picture; extinct animals are completely gone and can no longer be found on earth. Vocabulary cards
