First thing is you will need to set up an account with FEMA. https://training.fema.gov/.

once on the page scroll down looking on left side under the picture until you see (Register for a FEMA SID)

Click on the link and put your information in.

Once you have it be sure to save it in a safe place to remember it. Example make a note file on your smart phone titled sites / passwords and then inside put the site, the website address and your username and password.

Go back to the <a href="https://training.fema.gov/">https://training.fema.gov/</a> home page and hover over independent study. You will see IS-100.c, Is-700.b. click in the search bar and type in ICS 200 and when the results pop up choose the IS-200.c, Do the same for ICS 800 and choose IS-800.D.

Choose course to do, follow prompts to complete.

You will need to do these in order 100, 200, 700, 800.

This assignment though is for IS 100.c you must go through it completely and take the test. Once passed successfully you will receive a certificate. Save a copy of it to your computer in a file of your choosing for safe keeping and easy access.

It is to be completed by and a copy of your certificate submitted into this assignment as a PDF file. You are also asked to email me a copy to place in your file at school.

ICS 100c assignment is due on October 21, 2024, by 1700 hours.

ICS 200c assignment is due on November 11, 2024, by 1700 hours.

ICS 700b assignment is due on December 11, 2024, by 1700 hours.

ICS 800d assignment is due on January 20, 2025, by 1700 hours.

Failure to submit this assignment will result in a zero in the gradebook and you will not be able to complete this class and test until you do so.
