When and where is the Summer Gathering taking place?

This year's Summer Gathering is taking place at the Brady Arts and Community Centre, London, 192-196 Hanbury St, E1 5HU on Saturday 5th September. The event will start at 9.30am and end at 5.30pm, before optional drinks until 8pm (all included with your ticket).

What kind of accessibility needs can you accommodate?

The venue is fully wheelchair-accessible, and our events will be structured to accommodate anyone with mobility issues. The space will have gender-neutral, wheelchair-accessible toilets and a quiet room for anyone who needs to exit the main space at any time.

There is ample seating throughout the venue. There will be a 15-minute break between sessions and a 1-hour lunch break. All the food will accommodate plant-based diets (with gluten-free options), but let us know if you have a specific dietary need.
