Time	Activity
2 mins	Hand out the Gear Up workbook You will need to print the workbooks if you would like students to have a copy each.
30 mins	Play the Gear Up video main presentation The video can be played and paused where necessary.

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	The video starts with a quick true or false game. You can make your own 'true' and 'false' cards for students to hold up, or just ask students to do a show of hands to vote.	
10-20 mins	Activity: explore your options Ask students to turn to page 14 in their workbooks. Pages 14-18 outline some useful websites students might like to explore to help them decide on their next steps. Allow the students to explore the websites, and make sure they write notes in their workbooks if using these.	
	This could be an activity for a different session if there is not enough time.	
5 mins	Wrap up Highlight the importance of GCSEs - they are vital for any job/university as they will have seen in the activity.	
	Explain that it is not a linear process, students will probably change their minds and that is fine - just need to be aware of what their options are and what they need to get there. Everyone's pathway is different - use your own examples if you have any.
