Description

Over the next week, in groups of 2, you will develop a 15-20 minute live action green screen video explaining one major childhood development theory. Green screen video technology allows you to change the background of your video.

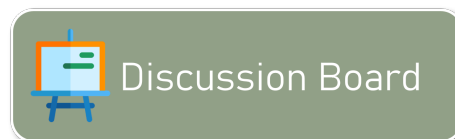
Choose from the list of theories provided in Unit 2. Address the 5 “Ws”: Who, What, Where, When and Why and look at both historical and current application of the theory.

Instructions

- Choose a child development theory from the list
- Film a 15-20 minute video that answers the 5 “Ws” on the theory
- The video must be filmed using a green screen. Both group members must appear and speak in the video, either at the same time or separately. Visit the library for information about booking a studio space with a green screen.
- At least one green screen background must be applied when editing the video. Be creative!
- Video must be saved as an MP4 and emailed to your professor at your.prof@yourcollege.ca
