Executive Order 16: Resolution of the Big Disaster

May 14, 2021

Whereas, the Governor's Office has reassessed the largeness issue in the State of Superior;

Whereas, upon reinspection, the Governor's Office has discovered that the Sangchris Lake State Park campgrounds are actually significantly larger than the state Senate's original chambers, on account of having neither walls nor ceiling;

Whereas, this effectively corrupts the original intent of the previous order, and justifies its revocation;

Whereas, this reassessment of the state of big disaster proclaimed in EO15 has ultimately revealed that the State of Superior is, in fact, not as large as the state government originally believed;

Whereas, this revelation represents an abject victory of the state government's attempt to address the largeness of the state, thereby necessitating its termination;

Now, therefore, I, Charles "Citizen" Baines, Governor of the State of Superior, by the powers vested in me by sections 7(6) and 7(9) of the Superior Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305, do hereby proclaim as follows:

Section I: Dismissal of State of Big Disaster

1. Sections II-IV of EO15 are hereby rescinded in their entirety.
2. The State of Big Disaster originally declared in EO15 is hereby terminated on the grounds that the source of the disaster has been resolved.
3. The state Senate of the State of Superior is hereby instructed to return to operating normally within the state Senate chamber of the Superior Capitol Building in Springfield.

Section II: Erection of David

1. A recreation of Michaelangelo's renaissance sculpture known colloquially as "David" shall be erected within the atrium of the Superior Capitol Building.
2. This statue will occupy the exact location previously occupied by the statue of Henry Wallace, which shall be moved into storage for the foreseeable future.

Section III: Effective Date

1. This order shall go into effect immediately upon its filing in the State Register.
