A. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:

1. You must earn **a minimum of 10 points** from no more than 5 of last semester's grades.

a. The first **4 points** must be from **LIST I** (unless you are a senior applying for membership in Jan).

b. The next **3 points** must be from **LISTS I or II**.

c. The remaining points may come from any **LIST (I, II, or III)**.

2. You must use **no more than 5 courses** to qualify.

3. **No** points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving office/teaching assistant, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.

4. CSF points are granted as follow:

\* a grade of **A = 3** CSF points

\* a grade of **B = 1** CSF point

\* a grade of **C = 0** CSF points

\* a grade of D or F in **ANY** course disqualifies you from membership at this time.

\* **One additional CSF point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP or Honors course, up to maximum of two points per semester. And remember:**

1. Semester membership is based on work done in the **previous** semester.

2. You must **reapply *each*** semester.

3. Courses you may use are listed on the reverse side. They are divided into LISTS I, II, and III.

C. **List the 4 or 5 courses** you are using to qualify in the proper location below. Consult the **LISTS** on the reverse side.

TOTAL POINTS from LIST I <u>must be</u> <u>at least 4</u> except for seniors applying in February or June		

List II Courses	Grade	Pts.
TOTAL POINTS from LISTS I and II <u>must be at least 7</u>		

List III Courses	Grade	Pts.
GRAND TOTAL of POINTS from all LISTS: <u>must be at</u> <u>least 10</u>
