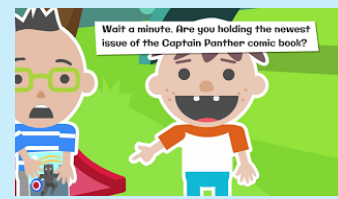

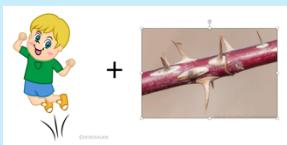

III. Health Sessions

a. Discussion

Peer pressure is the influence wielded by people within the same social group. It is also the term used to describe the effect this influence has on a person to conform in order to be accepted by the group. Often, peers are thought of as friends, but peers can be anyone of a similar status, such as people who are the same age, who have the same abilities, or who share a social status.

Peer pressure is commonly thought of in a negative light, but in reality, it's not always a bad thing. Sometimes peer pressure is used to positively influence people, such as when teens work toward common goals such as doing well in school or helping out in their community. Learning about acceptable group norms can be a positive part of learning how to

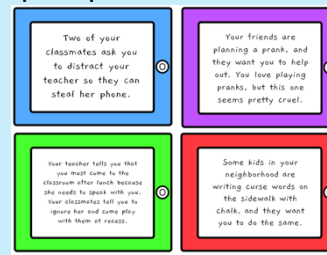

make no decisions at all and allow others to do it for us. There are also times we make snap decisions. We quickly decide without carefully assessing the situation.
Steps in making responsible choices
Step 1: Define the problem. What is really the problem at hand? Do you really need to solve it?
Step 2: Get helpful information. Ask your trusted people about it. Read information in different trusted sources.

Step 3: Enumerate your options. In this step, you list the possible solutions. Take time to think about possible ways on how you are going to handle a situation.

Step 4: Identify possible results. Each choice that you will make will have positive and negative results.

Step 5: Make a decision. After thinking of some solutions,

i in the middle and end with e. They are pronounced with a long /ī/ sound as in ice, time, and kite.

The word *Hope* is spelled with letter **o** in the middle and ends with letter **e**. It is pronounced with a long /ō/ sound as in bone, rope, and cone. The words *Luke* and *flute* are words with letter **u** in the middle and end with letter **e**. They are pronounced with a long /ū/ sound as in blue, glue, and clue.

However, long /ū/ can be also sounded as in cute, mute, cube, and tune.

Remember, a word with a short vowel is changed into a long vowel by placing a silent letter “e” at the end of a word. A long vowel is pronounced the same way as the name of the letter itself.
