- Serving as the primary point of contact for investors, and provide them with GFI resources.
- Providing consulting/advisory services to entrepreneurs, including assistance with business plan development and evaluation, feedback on pitch decks, communication with investors, and scaling with both suppliers and customers.
- Executing any other roles or responsibilities as communicated by the Managing Director and performing other duties as assigned.

Who We're Looking For

The Business Engagement Manager must have:

- A Bachelor's degree (MBA or equivalent experience preferred).
- A minimum of 3 years of relevant work experience in a consulting or business area.
- Understanding of entrepreneurship in Israel and fundraising for start-ups.
- Familiarity with the alternative protein industry (plant-based meat, eggs, and dairy; cultivated meat; and fermentation) a plus.
- Strong analytical, writing, and presentation skills in both English and Hebrew.
- Persuasive and engaging interpersonal skills; the ability to build effective working relationships with senior executives and investors.
- Strong support for GFI's philosophy, commitment to the objectives of the organization, and the ability to professionally advocate GFI's positions, demonstrated interest in public health, environmentalism, animal protection, or hunger relief.
