Idaho Adventure for 14- and 15-Year-Olds Travel and Logistics

We look forward to meeting you! Please wait to make travel plans until after NOLS Admissions clears your health form. As you prepare for your course, please be sure to double check the following:

- Flying to Jackson, WY you should arrive between 12:00 pm and 4:00 pm the
 day before your course start date. You are responsible for making a reservation
 with Jackson Hole Driver Provider, <u>reservations@driverprovider.com</u>, for a shuttle
 to NOLS Teton Valley. A NOLS Staff member will meet you in baggage claim.
- Flying from Jackson, WY book your departure the morning after your course ends, between 6:30am and 11:00am. The Driver Provider will pick up students at 4:45am the day after their course ends. A NOLS staff member will accompany the group to help folks check in. You are responsible for making a reservation with Jackson Hole Driver Provider, reservations@driverprovider.com to reserve a seat on the shuttle between the airport and NOLS Teton Valley at the start and end of your course. Specify "round trip" when you make your reservation.
- A current parent/guardian email address on file with Admissions we will send out an email confirming students have arrived at NOLS Teton Valley when the shuttle drops them off from the airport. Please add a preferred email to receive confirmation that your child has arrived. If you do not have email and would like arrival confirmation, please call NOLS Teton Valley (208-354-8443) on the course start date.

Unaccompanied Minors

Please contact NOLS Admissions at <u>admissions@nols.edu</u> to get the contact information for the custodian one week before the course begins. Unaccompanied minors must schedule flights for the time when NOLS staff will be at the airport.

For the return flight home, a receipt of payment for unaccompanied minor travel is required at check-in. Failure to provide this receipt may result in additional airline fees/expenses.

If Delayed

If your arrival is delayed because of weather or other reasons, please:

1. Rebook for the next available flight as soon as you can.

Notifying NOLS of Your Travel Plans

Please add your travel plans to the travel and logistics section of your student Dashboard at least two weeks before your course begins. NOLS Teton Valley will meet 15-30 students for each course start date; knowing our students' travel arrangements will help us track down anyone who doesn't arrive as scheduled. If you are driving please contact your Admissions Officer.

Meals

The Jackson airport has very limited food options, so we ask students to pack a substantial sack lunch on the day they travel. If you arrive on a noon flight, you may have several hours to wait before the shuttle departs. We will provide dinner on the arrival night at 6 pm.

Driving to NOLS Teton Valley

We are just south of Driggs, Idaho. From Driggs, drive south two miles on Hwy. 33. Turn left on 2000 South. Drive ~2 miles to a two story brick building on your left. That's us! From Jackson, Wyoming, drive over Teton Pass. Continue north on Hwy. 33, towards Driggs. One quarter (1/4) mile past the drive-in theater (with a big potato parked out front) turn right on 2000 South. Finish as above.

If you are driving, plan to arrive at NOLS Teton Valley at 5:00 p.m. the day before your course start date. This will coincide with the arrival of your coursemates on the shuttle from Jackson. (**Note**: We do not have the staff or facilities to accommodate students who arrive early. Please help us prepare for your course by arriving on time. You are welcome to visit in the afternoon, though, and we will be happy to point out options for you in the valley until it is time to meet.)

On departure, students can be picked up between 7 p.m. and 9 p.m. the last night of the course **or** before 9:00 a.m. the morning after the course ends.

Student Mail

Mail is slow in these parts—often taking 10 or more days to arrive. Mail is delivered before and after the course only (no mail is delivered to students in the field). We will make every effort to get mail to students on courses, but there is no guarantee.

Expedition Behavior Starts in Town

You will learn much about what we call expedition behavior on your course. We expect you to demonstrate attention to the course, care for self, others and property while at NOLS Teton Valley as well as in the backcountry.

Collectively the group sets the tone for the course at an orientation meeting the evening you arrive. You will spend your first night camping in tents in the field outside our base building. This gives you a jumpstart on skills for the following day, when your expedition begins in earnest.
