Enter all the names in your advisory and delete names after each student is selected to play a game.  Mummy Wrap: 5 student roles: Mummy, paper unraveler, wrapper, timer/coach, picture taker. Students have 1 minute to cover a student (like a mummy) as much as possible from head to toe using 1 roll of toilet paper. upload a picture to this slideshow and a winner will be selected (for bragging rights)  • There is also a new "best dressed room" category to our traditional halloween contest. Skeletone Shake: 2 teams of 3 (6 students total) The players pick up one bag at a time and give it a shake, trying to determine how many "bones" (candy corn) are in the bag. The players must hold the bag from the top when shaking and are not allowed to squeeze the bag inorder to feel the number of bones. The players must put the bags in a row in order from the least number of bones to the highest number of bones. The team that makes the most correct row of Halloween skeleton bones is the winner! (recommend using 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, & 9 pieces in each of the 6 bags)

<u>Candy Corn Stacking Game</u>: 2 + Students face off to see who can stack the most corn in 1 minute. Because students are using gloves you could have more students challenge the winners. Also those who like candy corn can eat it as long as gloves are used throughout the game.

Halloween Scattergories: Additional Time, Game Option Scattergory cards: Print for each student or use a projector. instructional video

- In place of box timer: Phone timer or this web timer
- In place of dice: Go through the alphabet in your head and have a student tell you when to stop.
