STUDENTS

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS REGARDING STUDENT DETENTION

I. AFTERSCHOOL DETENTION

A. ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS

- Walkers may be detained on the day of the offense provided the parent is contacted. If contact is not made, then the student would be detained on the next school day. This detention period would be limited to 25 minutes for elementary school students and 35 minutes for middle school students.
- 2. Bus students will ordinarily receive a 24 hour warning prior to being detained after school. However, this provision will be waived whenever a mutual agreement has been made between the parent and the teacher.

B. HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

- 1. High school students may be detained after school for disciplinary reasons on the day of the offense, provided the precautions noted in the policy have been observed. Students are to be given the opportunity to telephone home for transportation or may take the late bus home if available.
- Parents of chronic offenders will be contacted by school officials whenever required. It is expected that school officials will contact and personally confer with parents of chronic offenders.

II. LUNCH DETENTION

Students may serve a lunch detention as a disciplinary consequence. It is expected that school officials contact parents prior to the lunch detention occurring.
