<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Assessment Option 1: CAASPP:</b> Passing the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) for English Language Arts, or any successor test, in grade 11, at or above “standard met” achievement level	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Assessment Option 1: World Language Advanced Placement exam,</b> including American Sign Language, with a score of 3 or higher
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Assessment Options 2-3-AP or IB Exam:</b> Passing an English Advanced Placement (score of 3 or higher) <b>OR</b> an English A International Baccalaureate Examination (score of 4 or higher)	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Assessment Option 2: International Baccalaureate (IB) Language B HL or SL exam</b> with a score of 4 or higher

<b>Additional English Proficiency Requirement for English Learners Only:</b> <input type="checkbox"/> In addition to the requirements mentioned above, students who are classified as English learners must attain an oral language composite score of level 4 on the English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC).	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Assessment Option 4: District-Approved Assessment:</b> Pass a locally approved language examination that, at a minimum, assesses speaking, reading, and writing in a language other than English at the proficient level or higher (Intermediate high +) and meets the rigor of a four year high school course



## Dual Language Program: Four Year Plan

\*\*\*Classes labeled as Spanish Immersion courses are required\*\*\*If a student fails the course, they need to retake the course in Spanish during the school year. (Spanish Immersion courses are not offered during credit recovery OR Summer School.) Dual Language students also qualify for the California Seal of Biliteracy if the pathway is continued.
