- Combine the granulated sugar, light corn syrup and water in a heavy saucepan.
- Cook over medium-high heat until the hard-crack stage. (When the candy caramel cracks, then dip into cold water).
- Remove from heat.
- Add the peppermint oil or other flavour. Stir well.
- Pour onto the cookie sheet.
- Sprinkle with more powdered sugar.

- Cut with a knife as soon as cool enough to handle.
