Provide a general synopsis of what the course/activity covered/contained.

The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) established the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) discretionary program with \$5 billion in appropriated funds over 5 years (2022-2026). The SS4A program funds regional, local, and Tribal initiatives through grants to prevent roadway deaths and serious injuries. In this session, several local governments in Maryland will highlight their SS4A efforts, including the grant application process, what they are using the funds for, and lessons learned. Agencies will detail their experiences including initial outreach, working with the public to advance the concept of roadway safety, the process for selection/prioritization of demonstration and implementation projects, and eventual construction. Each agency will provide a brief overview of their efforts, followed by a panel discussion and Q&A.
