Establish consistent opportunities to enhance visibility and access to civic education and the electoral process. The committee works largely within the Tulsa Voter Coalition to enhance the ways in which we engage with current, lapsed, and future voters within the Tulsa metropolitan area.

Meeting Schedule

LWV team did not have an established cadence due to members already coordinating regularly.

Successes

- LWV-funded Tulsa Voter Coalition compiles localized data and demographic insight to ensure outreach and civic education are contextually appropriate. Over 1,200 individuals were engaged between July 2024 November 2024.
- E&A along with other LWV members hosted both the University of Tulsa/Tulsa World mayoral forum and Tulsa Community College's metro campus.
- Established a partnership with Tu's civic engagement department in addition to opening up work study programs for engaged university students.

Challenges

- Capacity of the committee was limited due to the lack of individuals who did
 not have other active roles in the league. Any efforts for meeting and/or
 directive engagement was limited (admin director, president, & state league
 president);
- Low board engagement requires a lot more external collaboration to complete E&A activities.
- Much of the work fell on Voter Services committee

 Scope of work for the committee should be an iterative process with some "requirements" set out for the year ahead (e.g. specific forums or bill overviews)

General Recommendations for Incoming Committee

- Re: Committee structure:
 - Minimum 5 members
 - Mixture of members outside of leadership to ensure lessened time constraints
 - Encourage newer board members to join- modify the committee scope to sound more enticing;
 - Specific skills for this committee:
 - Network of educators, legislators, and local politicians to engage for forum events;
 - Programmatic and operational interest to ensure the events are run properly;
 - Moderate level of capacity to volunteer in-person hours or backend logistic/reach-out support.
