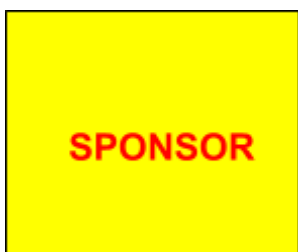

1. VENUE

TERENGGANU MONSOON CHALLENGE TMC 2023 will be held on the 28th Dec to 31st Dec 2023 at the Duyong Marina & Resort Pulau Duyong, Kuala Terengganu, Terengganu.

2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

- 2.1. The event is hosted by state of Terengganu is organized by Terengganu Sailing Association (TSA) in collaboration with UMT Sailing Training Centre (PLP UMT) and Terengganu Windsurfing Association (TWSA) under the auspices of Majlis Sukan Negeri Terengganu (MSNT) and the Malaysian Sailing Association (MSA).
- 2.2. This Organizing Authority shall appoint an Organizing Committee and a Race Committee.

3. RULES

- 3.1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the current **Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024**, the **Notice of Race**, the **Sailing Instructions** and **Supplementary Sailing Instruction** for Optimist Team Race.
- 3.2. The Class Rules of the participating classes that will be amended as required..
- 3.3. No national prescriptions will apply.
- 3.4. Rule RRS Appendix "P" will apply for the relevant classes
- 3.5. **[DP]** denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the protest committee.
[NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat.
This changes RRS 60.1 (a).
- 3.6. The first three sentences of Rule 61.1(a) are changed to 'The protesting boat shall inform the other boat at the first reasonable opportunity. When her protest will concern an incident in the racing area she shall hail 'Protest'. She shall inform the Race Committee of the sail number of boat/s being protested at the finishing line immediately after finishing.'
- 3.7. If there is conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions (SI's), the SI's will take precedence (changes RRS: 63.7).
- 3.8. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

4. JURY

- 4.1. The Jury/Protest Committee will be appointed by the organizer and will act in accordance with RRS 70.5 (b) and Appendix N. Decision of this Jury/Protest Committee is final and not subject to appeal.

5. **ADVERTISING**

Boards/Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

6. **EVENT CLASSES & CATEGORIES**

6.1. The event **TMC 2023 Fleet Challenge** will consist of categories and classes as follow:

6.1.1. Optimist Overall, Optimist Divisions and Optimist Girl

6.1.2. ILCA 7 Open, ILCA 6 Men & Women and ILCA 4 Boy & Girls, ILCA 4 Under 16yrs Boys & Girls

6.1.3. Int 420 Men & Women

6.1.4. Windsurf Techno 293 Boy & Girls

6.1.5. Windsurf RS-One Men & Women

6.1.6. Byte CII

6.2. For **TMC 2023 Novice Fleet Challenge**:

6.2.1. Optimist Division A, B, C, D (Boy & Girls)

6.2.2. Windsurfing Junior Rig 15 under & 12 under (Boy & Girls)

6.3. For **TMC 2023 Optimist Team Race**:

6.3.1. Open to 16 teams only with double knock-out format.

6.3.2. Only the hosted team is allowed to send 2 teams, other teams are only allowed to send 1 team.

6.4. For **TMC 2023 UMT-IPT OPEN**:

6.4.1. ILCA 6 Men

6.4.2. ILCA 6 Women

6.4.3. Windsurfing Junior Rig Men

6.4.4. Windsurfing Junior Rig Women

6.5. For **HANSA (Handicap Sailing) Monsoon Challenge** will be:

6.5.1. ACCESS 2.3 Male

6.5.2. ACCESS 2.3 Female

6.6. For **RC IOM Monsoon Challenge** will be:

6.6.1. IOM boat: (Race on 30th - 31st Dec 2023)

6.7. **Int 470 Speed Race** (Limited entry with 1st come 1st served)

6.8. A minimum of 4 entries is required to form a class event category. If the minimum number of 4 entries is not received for any particular class, the decision to allow the event to be included will be at the discretion of the Organizing Authority. The OA may combine the male & female to be an Open Class event or combine the different classes as Open class.

7. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 7.1. The regatta is open to all boats/boards listed of the competing classes.
- 7.2. A minimum of 4 entries in each class is required to constitute a class of event.
- 7.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing an on-line entry form registration before 10th December 2023 at: <https://form.jotform.com/233044107364044>
- 7.4. **Optimist** participants may also enter more than 1 event class (only **ILCA 4 Under 16yrs or Windsurfing Junior Under 16 yrs/ Under 13yrs or Byte CII event**).
- 7.5. Age Division:
 - 7.5.1. For Optimist class shall be under 16 years of age (born on 2008 or after) and for sub division will be:
 - 7.5.1.1. Division 'A' - born on between 2008 to 2010
 - 7.5.1.2. Optimist Division 'B' - born in between 2011 to 2012
 - 7.5.1.3. Optimist Division 'C' - born on 2013 and after
 - 7.5.2. ILCA 4 Clas:
 - 7.5.2.1. ILCA 4 Boys & Girls class shall be under 18 years of age (born in 2006 or after).
 - 7.5.2.2. ILCA 4 Boys & Girls under 16 yrs shall be under 18 years of age (born in 2008 or after).
 - 7.5.3. Techno 293 class shall be under 18 years of age (born on 2006 or after)
 - 7.5.4. Byte C II class shall be under 16 yrs shall be under 18 years of age (born in 2008 or after).
- 7.6. For **TMC 2023 Novice Fleet Challenge**:
 - 7.6.1. Only for Malaysian sailors only which participants have never participated in any competition abroad (outside their state)
 - 7.6.2. For Optimist age Division are as follow:
 - 7.6.2.1. Division 'A' - born on between 2008 to 2010
 - 7.6.2.2. Optimist Division 'B' - born in between 2011 to 2012
 - 7.6.2.3. Optimist Division 'C' - born in between 2013 to 2014
 - 7.6.2.4. Optimist Division 'D' - born on 2015 or after
 - 7.6.3. For Windsurfing Junior Rig 15 under – born on 2008 to 2010
 - 7.6.4. For Windsurfing Junior Rig 12 under – born in 2011 or after.
- 7.7. For **Optimist Team Racing** the entry:
 - 7.7.1. is limited to the first 16 entries only
 - 7.7.2. with age limit to under 16 yrs only
 - 7.7.3. maximum of 5 sailors per team with at least 1 sailors with different gender in the team list registration (4 only during races & 1 reserve)
- 7.8. The following shall be present upon registration day:
 - 7.8.1. Original Entry Form
 - 7.8.2. Proof of age (IC or Passport)

8. ENTRY FEE

- 8.1. Exceptional to para **6.1.6 (Byte Class)** 6.2 & 6.5, the entrance fee are as follow:
- 8.1.1. **RM 120** per participant for all classes and official; and
 - 8.1.2. **RM 50** per participant for second entry and so on in ILCA 4 Under 16yrs, Windsurfing Junior Rig Under 16yrs, Windsurfing Junior Rig Under 13yrs **and Byte CII Under 16yrs.**
- 8.2. This fee will cover lunch on race day, goodies if any, certificate of participation and the cost of any social events during the championship.
- 8.3. For **TMC 2023 Novice Fleet Challenge and Byte CII** the entry fee is;
- 8.3.1. **RM180** which entitled for:
Racing Boats, which will be provided by organizers that will be used rotationally which will not be ground for any protest for any malfunction incurred.
 - 8.3.2. **RM120** only for sailors who use their own boat and equipment.
 - 8.3.3. For Optimist class sailors need to bring their own sails, spars, rigging, ratchet block, foils and buoyancy bags.
 - 8.3.4. The fee also will cover lunch on race day, goodies if any, certificate of participation and the cost of any social events during the championship.
- 8.4. For **TMC 2023 Hansa Fleet Challenge** the entry fee is **USD150** which entitled for:
- 8.4.1. Racing Boats, which will be provided by organizers that will be used rotationally which will not be ground for any protest for any malfunction incurred.
 - 8.4.2. Accommodation from 28th to 31st Dec 2023..
 - 8.4.3. Transportation from airport to venue and daily transportation from accommodation to venue
 - 8.4.4. The fee also will cover lunch on race day, goodies if any, certificate of participation and the cost of any social events during the championship.
 - 8.4.5. Participants are required to bring their own sail only and rigging if required.

9. COMPETITION FORMAT

- 9.1. With an exception of para 6.3 & 6.5, the regatta will consist of a single fleet racing.
- 9.2. **9 races** are scheduled with at least 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series for an event
- 9.3. For **Optimist Team Racing, RC IOM** and **Speed Race** (Int 470) the format of races will be stated in Supplementary Sailing Instruction (SSI) for each.

- 10.2. Except for 1st Racing Day on Thursday; the scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is at 1000H
- 10.3. There will be 3 races to be sailed each day, the race officer may be conducting one extra race each racing day. The number of races scheduled for the series shall be nine races (9).
- 10.4. No Warning Signal will be made after 1530 hours on the last racing Day Sunday, 31st Dec 2023, except for special events in the Sponsor Sumbangsih Cup Race if any.

11. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instruction will be available during registration at the Race Secretariat on Thursday, 28th December 2023.

12. **RACING AREA & THE COURSES**

- 12.1. The diagrams in Attachment 1 show the racing area to be sailed.
- 12.2. Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

13. **SCORING**

- 13.1. Low point scoring system of Appendix A RRS will be apply
- 13.2. At least 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 13.3. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 13.4. When 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 13.5. The Best Team will be awarded to the team that collected the most winning points as per each race in each class competing in the event.
 - 13.5.1. For classes with 10 and more boats the points will be 10 points for 1st place, 9 points for 2nd places and so on. Places no 10 will get 1 point and no point for 11 places onward.
 - 13.5.2. For classes less than 10 boats, the score will be the same with places number 1 will get the point with total of boats and so on for the last places will get 1 point.
- 13.6. Best male and female sailors will be awarded to the sailors with the most points follows the same system for best team, only of her/his best class result (not subclass/Division).

14. **PERSONAL BUOYANCY**

Except as stated in the class rule; all competitors shall bring their own personal buoyancy which must be capable of being fastened at all time while afloat, RRS 40 will be applied.

15. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 15.1. Participants compete in the championship entirely at their own risk and responsibility. See Rule 4, Decision to Race.
- 15.2. The Organizing Authority and all others involved in the organization of the event accept no liability for any loss or material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

16. **SUPPORT BOATS**

Team support boats are required to inform the Secretariat by filling-up a form & upon approval from the organizer.

17. **BERTHING/BOAT PARKING**

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

18. **RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

19. **PRIZES**

- 19.1. Medals will be awarded to the top 3 winners of each class except for Optimist Overall will be for top 10 winners and for Optimist Girls will be for top 5 winners
- 19.2. Best sailors' winner will be based on their best result in the class/es entered, result on each race and totals of entry in his/her classes.
- 19.3. Best team winner will be based on the result of their participants in each race.

20. **MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT**

- 20.1. By participating in an event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority, their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition and after without compensation.
- 20.2. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority.
- 20.3. The top three competitors as well as the individual race winners may be required to attend a media press conference each day if any.
- 20.4. Competitors may be required for interviews at the regatta.

21. **SINGLE USE WATER BOTTLE AND PACK FOOD IN PLASTIC CONTAINER**

- 21.1. All competitors and officials are requested not to bring a 'single use' plastic bottle to the venue and racing area on water.
- 21.2. Drinking water can be refilled from water dispensers available at race secretariat area ashore and from RC boats on water.

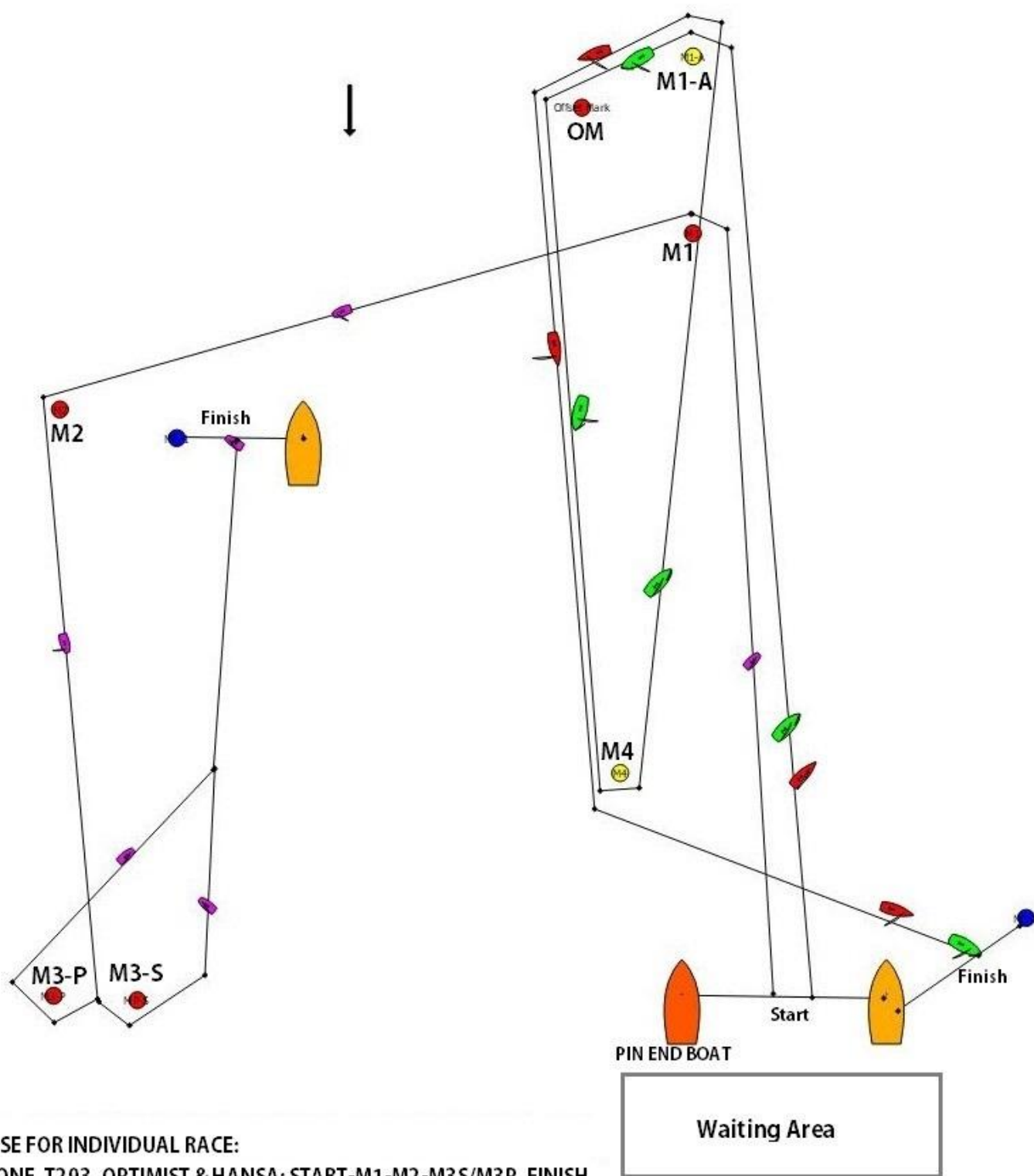
