

Fell Pony

Description: Native to Northern England. This pony averages 12 hands in height. Used for work, performance, driving, and dressage. Known for strength and hardiness of a mountain breed.

Characteristics: Small head with broad forehead and tapering to nose. Fine hair at heels, laid back and sloping shoulders.

Color: Black, Brown, Bay and Grey. Chestnuts, Piebald and skewbald are coat colors but are in secondary category. Excessive white is frowned upon but still eligible for registration in secondary category
