


# World Music Audition Assignment

## Audition Assignment for World Music:

For your audition we will need to see your ability to learn and play a few rhythm patterns. You can practice on a drum pad with sticks if you have them, but if you don't you can make your own instrument! Use pencils, sticks, or cooking utensils for sticks!
