Match Format

Warm-up will be 6-6 (includes serving) before the first match played for each team.

For subsequent matches the warm up will be 4-4 (includes serving).

Pool play games will consist of two games to 25

All pool play games will start with a score of 6.

Tournament games will be the best two out of three games to 25 points, with the score starting 0-0. Third game, if necessary, will be to 25.

There will not be a cap on any game, pool play or tournament.

Tournament Format

Top two teams in each pool will go to the 8 team single elimination **Gold Bracket at the Perry Park Center**. Third place team in each pool will go to the 4 team single elimination **Silver Bracket at Perryville High School**. Fourth place teams in each pool will go to the 4 team single elimination **Bronze Bracket at Perryville Middle School**. A copy of the brackets is on the following pages.

Tie breaker system

1. Head to Head
2. Head to Head point differential
3. Total Points of all games
4. Total Points given up of all games
5. One game play-off to 25 points (score starts 6-6)

To the Coaches

The home team is listed first on the schedule and is responsible for providing the official score keeper. The visiting team will provide the official libero tracker. Each team will provide a line judge. Coolers and other outside food items will not be permitted in the Perry Park Center. A hospitality room will be available for coaches, officials, and bus drivers. Players should bring their own water to drink. There will be concessions offered at every gym.

The Perry Park Center is usually very cold, dress accordingly.

Gyms will NOT open until 8:00am. Do not come before and expect to get in.
