# Resume Building:

- Organized, consistent, logical
  - Make it easy to read, follow a logical flow so recruiters can easily learn more about you as they work their way down.
  - Reverse chronological order
- Major Sections
  - Name, Contact Info.
    - Address → Put city and state, do not necessarily need to put full address if not comfortable
    - Can also put closest city/geographical area to you
  - o Academic Info.
  - o Professional Experiences/Projects
    - Can put work experience and projects under one category.
  - Hobbies, interests, skills, etc.
    - Show that you're personable, how you can connect beyond the workplace.

#### Networking:

- What is a network?
  - o Everyone you meet through all of your experiences are part of your network.
  - You never know where an opportunity can arise from! It's an ongoing part of life alongside having a strong work ethic.
- What makes a network valuable?
  - Internships, jobs, etc. can come from networking
- How to build your network:
  - Rutgers
    - Professors → Been through the industry, know companies. Get to know them!
    - Professional Events → Career Fairs
      - Organizations → Clubs
    - School! → Your peers and classmates
  - o LinkedIn
    - Showcase your skills, what you've done.
    - Use quotes & the word "and" to get the best LinkedIn search
      - EX: "LinkedIn" and "Ernest Mario School of Pharmacy" and "Rutgers" and "Bristol Myers Squibb" in Google to maximize network connections.
  - Friends

# Interviewing:

- Interviews tend to be comprised of 2 major parts:
  - o Behavioral → Tell me about yourself (keep it under a minute), hit major points on your resume.
    - Try to be as succinct as possible!
    - This focuses on learning your thought processes and how you think.
    - Technical → More catered towards the job and hard skills necessary.
- Practice makes perfect!

- Practice, <u>don't rehearse</u>, people want to work with people. If you run a script too many times in your head, you may come off sounding like a robot.
- People want to work with PEOPLE! Make it flow like a conversation.
- Know the COMPANY and the POSITION you are interviewing for.
  - Often overlooked; keep an eye out about the description of the job itself
  - Makes a strong impact when talking to the recruiter
    - Question: "When X happens, how do you go about handling Y?"
- Tying in our conversations on resumes and networking.
  - Walk me through your resume
  - What have you heard about our team
    - Look at job description, look up people in the company on LinkedIn
- Don't forget about brain teasers!
  - Super far-fetched and ridiculous, but show off your skills.
  - What are they getting at with this question?
    - EX: "What do you want to talk about?"
