## **FFA JACKETS**

You do not have to order an FFA Jacket to be a member of the Aplington-Parkersburg FFA Chapter. If you want to get really involved and plan on doing a lot of contests, then it would be a good idea to order since it takes time to get them and you will utilize the jacket many times throughout the year.

Typically when ordering a jacket we take the current size and projected size of the student in a few years into account. If we/the student thinks they will grow a lot, it may be wise to wait to order and to borrow a jacket in the meantime. If the student doesn't think they will grow tons or we can project their growth peak- we can order a larger jacket to account for the growth. Nearly all students grow at least a little between 9th grade and completing high school.

FFA jackets are funny sizes- not like traditional clothing. Jackets will need to be tried on before ordering to make sure the right size gets ordered. It is better to order too big than too small.

Jackets are \$65- FFA will order the jackets and pay for the order but the students will reimburse the chapter for them. It's expected to have the money before the jacket arrives or before it can be taken. Checks can be made to A-P FFA. We also suggest you purchase the tie or scarf at the same time. Those are \$15 each. The total would be \$80 for the combo. If you cannot afford a jacket and would still like your own- please talk to Mr. Pudenz in more detail and we can likely work something out amongst our donors and Alumni and Supporters Chapter.
