This act includes keeping records all of the dates specified in Mr. Roy's act, but will also include event and session dates. This act also mandates that a google calendar be created and access be provided to the delegates. The dates are currently well kept and utilized through a google sheets document, but I feel that the system could be improved.

[2:16 PM] Ștefan Snagoveanu - Snagov: The act to repeal the Gazette act.

[2:16 PM] Tyler Mullins - New Athens: A bit of background on the Act: The Gazette Act transferred responsibility of the Gazettes from the Chair to the Ministry of Press and Promotion. That ministry is busy enough and it makes more sense to me for the Chair to manage them, since the Chair publishes the agendas and host sessions. Gazettes had fallen quite inactive during Mr. Roy's term as the ministry was preoccupied with other tasks. I've been publishing them during my term with the Minister's blessing, but after doing it for a while I think it's most efficient this way and should be kept this way. It's a small technicality on who's in charge of it, but I think that setting it up this way will help to ensure that it doesn't fall inactive again. This is ensured through the fact this places the responsibility on the Chair to ensure they're published, but also allows the Chair to delegate responsibility of the Gazette to the Minister if the Chair is unable to publish them, as delegation of duties is already a common practice in the cabinet.

If the minister fails to produce the Gazettes, they have no backup except for the Chair to step in and do their job, which is not a good practice.
