Milestones in 2010: The Year in Review

- Visitors came from 42 states and the District of Columbia, plus from 9 foreign countries
- ❖ There were 180+ appearances about museum activities run in more than 21 different media outlets
- ❖ Four new exhibitions and two *History Showcases* opened
- The Museum successfully completed the self-study phase for its re-accreditation through the American Association of Museums

Departing Trustees

With today's meeting, we mark the departure of two trustees from the Board. Cumulatively, they have given nearly 20 years of service. We are deeply grateful and indebted to them for their time, enthusiasm, and wise counsel. We welcome their continued support and involvement with the Museum in the years to follow:

Steven C. Adams

Steve Adams joined the Museum's Board of Trustees in 2005 and served on the Building Planning Committee during the 2006 Capital Campaign improvements, as well as on the Museum's Facilities Committee. For several years Steve was an instructor for the Kennebunk Adult Education course, "So You Think You Know Kennebunk," drawing upon the knowledge and experiences he has had living in Kennebunk for more than 40 years. Steve has been with Kennebunk Rotary since 1981, serving as its president in 1997-1998. Steve has been a chairman, officer or trustee with several organizations and committees, including the Town of Kennebunk Downtown Revitalization Committee, Town of Kennebunk Downtown Committee, Town of Kennebunk Historic Preservation Commission, MSAD #71 Board of Directors, York County Community Action, Cub Scout Pack #304, and the Kennebunk Alumni Association.

Bruce R. Jackson

Bruce moved from London to Kennebunk, Maine, in 2004, after a 30-year business career as an executive with IBM and AT&T. He has also been a professional speaker and presenter. Bruce owned and operated The English Meadows Inn and Tea Room in Lower Village Kennebunk until December 2010. A self-professed "history buff," Bruce has a degree in international studies from Johns Hopkins University. Bruce joined the Museum's Board of Trustees in 2005 and has served as the chair of the Museum's Collections Committee since 2007. He was also one of the founders of the Kennebunkport "Arts in the Inns" Festival.

Candidates Nominated As Officers, 2011 - 2012

Stephen P. Spofford, President

Steve is a native of Kennebunk, having grown up on Summer Street. His first involvement with the Museum was through his mother in the late 1970s. Steve has been on the Museum's Board of Trustees since 2002, has chaired the Facilities Committee since 2003, and has also served three years as Vice President. He became President of the Board in 2008 and successfully led the Museum through its capital improvements projects in 2008 and 2009. Steve is employed by the Kennebunk, Kennebunkport & Wells Water District. He is actively involved with South Congregational Church, has been a trustee at the Kennebunk Free Library, and is a former president of the alumni association for the University of Maine-Farmington.

Christopher J. Farr, Vice President

Chris became a full-time resident of Kennebunkport in 2001 after 15 years of being a summer and weekend visitor. His career has been in the field of Medical Imaging where he has focused on advanced imaging modalities such as MR, CT and nuclear medicine devices and in the treatment of cancer using radiation. He is currently Vice President of Sg2, a company based in Chicago that helps hospitals plan for new technologies. For many years, Chris headed Philips Medical Systems' business in North America and ran the Canadian operations of Philips during a time when the company was growing through mergers and acquisitions. His career in medical high technology began with Atomic Energy of Canada. He has worked extensively in Canada and the United States, as well as overseas with hospitals in South East Asia, Australia, Africa, and the UK. Immediately prior to joining Sg2, he owned and operated The Welby Inn in Kennebunkport. He has a MSc in physics from the University of Toronto in Canada and a BSc from King's College of the University of London, England. Chris joined the Board of Trustees in 2003 and became its Vice President in 2009. Chris has been instrumental in developing Board planning, policy, and assessment procedures.

Michael I. Montembeau, Secretary

Michael and his family moved back to Maine and settled in Kennebunk in 2006. Michael is a partner in a local law firm specializing in intellectual property law. Prior to his legal career, Michael worked as a geologist and environmental engineer with the U.S. EPA and Halliburton. Until recently, Michael was active in Saco Bay Rotary and served as President of the Rotary Club of Southbridge, Massachusetts during its centennial year. Michael has served as a board member and trustee of several organizations including Harrington Memorial Hospital, Community Bike Coalition, Southbridge Planning Board, and the Central Massachusetts Planning Commission. Michael joined the Museum's board in early 2010 and became its Secretary in June 2010.

David N. Moravick, Treasurer

David and his family have lived in Granite Point, Biddeford since 1985. He is currently Senior Vice President in the insurance division of Kennebunk Savings. Prior to this, he was Senior Loan Officer for Rivergreen Bank. He has been a trustee and officer on several boards, including the Kennebunk Rotary, United Way, McArthur Library Association and Trinity Episcopal Church. David joined the Museum's Board of Trustees in 2005 and has served for five years as Treasurer and chair of the Finance Committee, as well as a key member of the Building Planning Committee during the recent renovations. He has helped to shepherd the

Museum through its re-accreditation process with the American Association of Museums, and his organizational skills and creative thinking have contributed to broadening the Museum's audience and base of support.




