Principal's Report

2024-2025 school configuration: 15 regular classroom units, 345 students - population is constantly rising. This year we have 3 EAL teachers, 15 classroom teachers, a full-time guidance counselor, 2 TLAs, 3.5 IRTs, a reading specialist, phys ed, and music.

All class numbers are below cap, which is a change from last year. Class sizes are still high but there is a small amount of room in each grade before cap is reached.

The 8 grade three students in the split 2/3 class have indicated that they would like to spend some time with their grade three peers. The staff is developing a plan that balances the class community and the threes spending time with the other threes. To begin, the threes will be surveyed and those who want to spend lunch with the other classes will go into those classes on Fridays. Once the Fridays are up and running, additional days together may be added.
