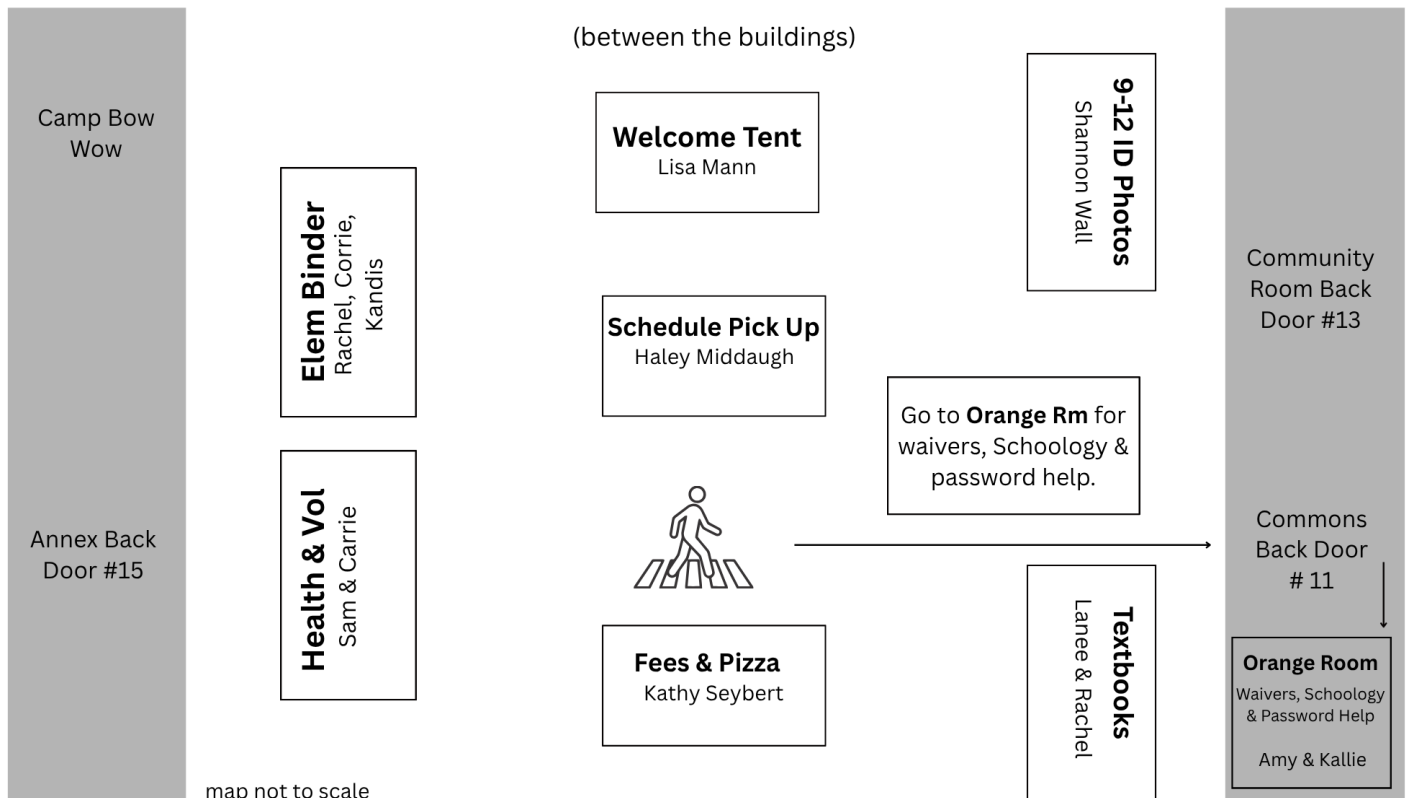

- ☐ **Schedule Pick Up Tent** Go to the Schedule Tent to pick up your student's class schedule and family car sign.
- ☐ **Elementary Binder Personalization Tent** Optional stop for elementary students.
- ☐ **Fees and Pizza Tent** If you have not already paid through Infinite Campus, you may pay fees and add money to your student's pizza account. You can also get information on how to help support Summit through fundraising.
- ☐ **Health and Volunteer Tent** If you have questions about your volunteer sign-up, stop by the Volunteer and Medical Tent. You can also drop off immunization waivers, medical paperwork and medication with our health aide.
- ☐ **Textbook Tent** You can drop off Summit textbooks you are finished with, as well as submit order forms for new textbooks at this tent. Requests will be filled on another date; you will be notified when your textbooks are ready for pick up.
- ☐ **ID Photos Tent** All 9-12 grade students are required to have their photograph taken for their student ID badge during Launch. ***Please make sure your student visits this tent.***
- ☐ **Waivers/Schoology/Passwords** Visit the Orange Room inside the main building for new student password setup, returning student password reset, Schoology questions and/or to complete the following waivers if you have not yet done so:
 - KG-12th Comprehensive Waiver (ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE THIS COMPLETED)
 - 9th-12th Grade Agreement (FOR ALL 9th-12th GRADE STUDENTS)
 - Parent Volunteer Waiver (FOR ANY PARENT/GUARDIAN VOLUNTEERING IN THE SCHOOL)
