- I. Monthly Financial Report - August-September 2022
- II. Fees Update
 - A. As of 10/8/22, 60 of 79 families have paid fee (76%)
 - B. Fundraising is strongly encouraged, but cannot be required
 - 1. Primary Fundraisers - BOA, World's Finest Chocolate (1st sale tentative dates - 10/10/22-11/1/22)
- III. World's Finest Chocolate Fundraiser (Confirmed Dates 10/24/22-11/16/22)
 - A. Asked to start out with 50 boxes
 - B. Tracking box requests using [Google Form](#)
 - 1. Families must prepay in Charms before picking up the box
 - 2. Lessens burden for treasurer - no more cash to count!
 - C. Cost of chocolate went up from \$33 to \$35 per box
 - 1. Each box valued at \$60 (each bar sells for \$1)
 - 2. \$35 goes to the company, \$25 goes to profit for student in Charms
 - D. Student would have to sell 3 boxes to cover \$75 piano department fee

 - B. Additional shirts beyond student shirt (included with department fee) have been charged in Charms (\$10/shirt)
