CHW Hub Mini Grant Non-Profit Nominations

The BCCP serves as a community advisory board for Metro Health's CHW Hub. We ask all BCCP members to recommend up to 5 nonprofit agencies that fit the following criteria:

- Focus on CHW related work to engage communities facing health disparity in at least one area below
 - Access to care
 - Food insecurity and nutrition
 - Health equity and social justice
 - Mental health and community resilience
 - Violence prevention
- Employ CHWs or those performing similar work
- Priority to grassroot and small nonprofit agencies

Discussion
