



Androids: Change Wi-Fi Setting

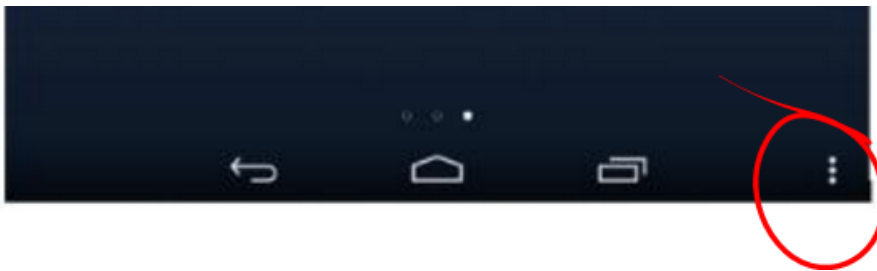
A new wireless access point has been created at school sites to help the android devices maintain a consistent internet connection. There is a small adjustment to be made on each android to switch to this new connection. This change is not mandatory as devices can continue on the old access point. However, as connectivity will improve, we recommend teachers make this change.

Note: This should only be done by teachers and staff as it involves a secure, district WiFi password.

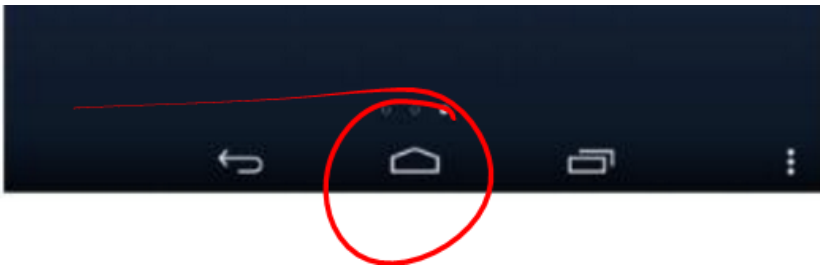
Directions - For Year 4 AND Year 5 Androids

From the home screen:

1. Tap the Additional Options icon (three dots) near the home screen icon at the bottom of the screen



2. Select Settings
3. Enter the passcode: 4100
4. Select Wi-Fi (for Y4 androids) or WLAN (for Y5 androids)
5. Tap I21WIRELESS and select Forget. (This step is VERY important!)
6. Tap **SDUSD-ANDROIDONLY**
7. Password: **Tablet2016** (Tip: check the box to “show password” for accuracy.)
8. Tap Connect
9. Check under **SDUSD-ANDROIDONLY** if it says “connected” you are good. If it says “Saved, secured with WPA” you have entered the password incorrectly. Follow the steps at the bottom of this document to make corrections.
10. Tap Home



Directions to Re-Enter the SDUSD-ANDROIDONLY Password (this may need to be done if the password was originally entered incorrectly and/or the Android is continuing to drop the internet signal):

1. Tap on SDUSD-ANDROIDONLY and hit FORGET
2. You should still see it on the screen – tap on it again and it will ask for a WPA password
3. Enter “Tablet2016” as the password
4. Hit CONNECT
5. If it was entered correctly, it should say CONNECTED under SDUSD-ANDROIDONLY
6. Hit the HOME button at the bottom middle to get back to the home screen
