New Hope Through God's Love Scholarship (Financial Aid Assistance) Guidelines

Deadline: July 7

Description of Scholarship (Financial Aid Assistance):

The New Hope Baptist Through God's (NHTGL) Scholarship (financial aid assistance) was established in 2018 with contributions from the members of the church to support post-secondary educational opportunities for current members. The scholarship (financial aid assistance) may be awarded to deserving graduating high school seniors or college students who are current, attending members of NHBC in Carbon Hill, AL. The scholarship (financial aid assistance) may provide all qualified applicant(s) awards annually in the amount of \$1,000 each to full-time students attending four-year college/universities and one award annually of \$500 for a full-time student attending community college. Scholarships (financial aid assistance) will be applied to the cost of undergraduate tuition, fees, room, board, and other college expenses.

Criteria:

To receive consideration, applicants must:

- be current, attending member(s) of NHBC (the contact at NTHGL will verify status of applicant(s) as current member)
- have a minimum cumulative GPA of a least 2.5 on most recent grade transcript
- be enrolled full-time during the academic year in a program leading to a two-year or four-year degree
- Student(s) must reapply each year, but will not be eligible beyond a maximum of four consecutive years of undergraduate study.
- In the event that the yearly applicant(s) pool has more qualified applicants than the maximum numbers of scholarships (financial aid assistance) available, those applicants with the highest cumulative GPA will receive the awards.

Application Process:

The application is available at NHBC in Carbon Hill, AL.

The following items must be submitted to the NHTGL point of contact (P.O.C)

- All application must be completed in full
- Grade transcript through the first semester of 12th grade high school senior, or most recent grade transcript for college students

- Three letters of recommendation from a staff member or clergy at NHBC. The applicant and all supplemental materials must be received by the deadline indicated in order to receive consideration.
- Incomplete applications will not be process

Selection Process:

A Student Aid Committee (SAC) composed of NHTGL Board will select recipient(s).

The committee reserves the right to rescind an award should a recipient's circumstance changes, such as failure to graduate from high school or failure to enroll at an accredited institution.

The SAC reserves the right to withhold the award in the event that no applicant(s) are deemed to meet the qualifications.

Payment Process:

Once recipient(s) have been selected, checks will be issued jointly to the college/university and to the recipient, will be mailed to the recipient's home address for the student to deliver to the college/university financial aid office.

Separate checks will be issued in for fall and spring semesters.

Check processing requires approximately two weeks.

Management of Fund:

The NHTGL Scholarship (financial aid assistance) is administered and funded by NHTGL, Carbon, Hill, AL. As fund grows, the number and dollar amount of scholarship (financial aid assistance) may be increased.

Contributions from the public may be made to fund at any time.

Gifts should be clearly designated for the NHTGL Scholarship (financial aid assistance) and mailed directly to the church.
