

For the first time GIVE Day will be a single day, recognized across the entire School Division on January 31, as part of the asynchronous Approaches to Learning (ATL) Day. Students of all ages are called to engage in service as action.

GIVE Day stands for **Get Involved, Value Everyone**. Since its inception in 2016, with a small group of 5th graders (now in 11th grade) and the Falls Church Elementary PTA, GIVE Day has fostered a culture of caring in FCCPS. Over the years, ongoing enthusiasm for these programs expanded the program to middle school and high school GIVE Day programs.

January is turning into GIVE Month - as our student GIVE Day Ambassadors work together to raise awareness and funds for their service projects. The elementary GIVE Day Club (33 5th graders) is working to raise \$6000 to make 1500+ food packs with Food for Others, addressing local food insecurity. The Mary Ellen Henderson Middle School GIVE Day Club (98 Ambassadors strong) are working to raise \$10,000 to pack 30,000 meals together in partnership with Rise Against Hunger, addressing global hunger. The Meridian GIVE Day Club is putting together Ignite: Service as Action on the importance of service learning (five on executive board, 50 members). There will also be an INOVA Bloodmobile on the secondary campus that morning.
