

FAQs - Analog Liberation Portrait Show '26

When/where is the show and opening? Opening is February 21st, 6-9pm, at Maple Leaf Gallery in Millvale. At 115 Sedgwick St, Pittsburgh, PA 15209. There is a sign for the gallery on the side of the building. Go down the stairs and enter there.

When can I drop off my work? Work can be dropped off on Feb 21st when it will be hung by the artist. Hanging must start promptly at 1.15/1.30. Please do not arrive early. There is a drawing class in the gallery before we hang the work and have asked that we do not interrupt. If you cannot make that date, please send someone in your place. Cara will lay out all the work, and after that is done, we will start hanging. Plan to be there about 2hr, though it will likely take less time.

I want to donate to AL for my participation in the show, how can I do that?

Paypal: @PatFrancart. There will also be a jar for cash at the opening night of the show.

Is there a guarantee that all of my work will be accepted? No. This is a juried show. Cara will do her best to include at least one piece from everyone, but in some cases, not all work is taken. If we are looking for stronger images, we may reach out once to see if you have others you can send. But again, that is still not a guarantee of acceptance.

When is the submission deadline? February 4th

When will I hear back about if my work is accepted?

February 6th

How many pieces can I submit? Up to (3)

Where do I upload my submission image files? In the link Cara provided in the email sent January 15th.

When do I pick up my work? March 21st, 3-5pm

Where do I park? There is street parking. There is a sign on the side of the building that says Gallery. Go down the stairs underneath it and our entrance is there.

Who is printing labels? Analog Liberation

How will I be paid if my work sells? You will be paid by the method you indicate on your label template. **PLEASE FILL IN ALL PAYMENT INFO.** Do not just put "Paypal" for example. We need your name on the e-payment platform.

Do I need to label my work when I drop it off? Yes, something attached to the back is fine. But we need to know which work belongs to whom. Work that is not labeled will not be in the show.

What if my work contains nudity, political or religious themes? Please do not submit work with nudity. This is an all-ages event. Please avoid submitting work with religious or political themes.

How do I price my work? Pricing work is a very personal choice. Consider the time, effort, and cost that you have in it, and how much you want to get back. Also consider what a reasonable w[oprice point is that someone could afford.

Does AL take a commission? No

Do I need an artist statement? No, this show will not have one. If you want to say anything short about your work, there is a spot for that in the application form, though it's not required.

I have friends/family that couldn't make opening night but want to see the show. When is the gallery open after the exhibition? March 7th and 21st, 1-3pm

Do I need to attend the opening night exhibition? We ask that you make every effort to. It not only supports your own work but shows support for your fellow artists. You don't need to stay the entire time but at least stopping by is encouraged.

Does my work need to arrive ready to be hung and framed? Yes. Wire or saw tooth hangers are53ady to hang, we cannot hang it.

Can I sell merchandise like prints, books, or stickers of my work? Yes. Let Cara know ahead of time what you are bringing so we make sure there is enough table space for it on a merch table.

Anything else I need to know about opening night? All artists are expected to contribute a food or drink item. A list of requested items will be provided the week before the show, and artists can fill in what they will bring. Feel free to drop off your work when you come in to hang your work. That way it is already set up when the show starts. There is a refrigerator if your item is cold. If you can't bring it at that time, please consider arriving at least 15min before the show so that food/drinks are set up before attendees start to arrive.
