

Professional Connections Foundation

The Professional Connections Foundation (PCF) is a program created by the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR) with the goal of providing high school students with disabilities the opportunity to build a foundation of important work skills.



A PCF will consist of group presentations on workplace readiness and job exploration, and exploration of the world of work through job shadows, informational and mock interviews, or in-person workplace tours and acquisition of prerequisite work documents (e.g., photo ID, work permits, financial documentation). The PCF will occur for 30 hours in the summer, 15 hours of instruction and 15 hours of job shadows in the community.

Students who successfully complete the program by attending all activities will receive a \$50 stipend.
