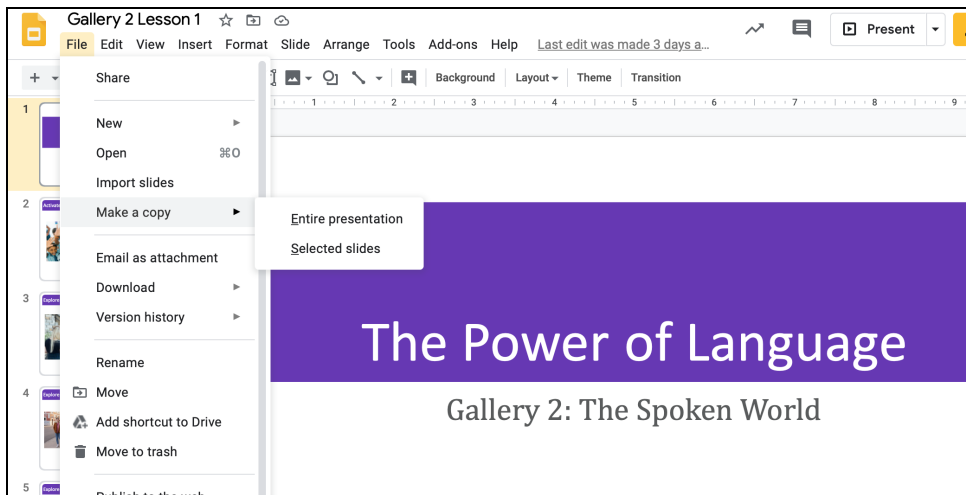


How to Use Planet Word Educator Resources

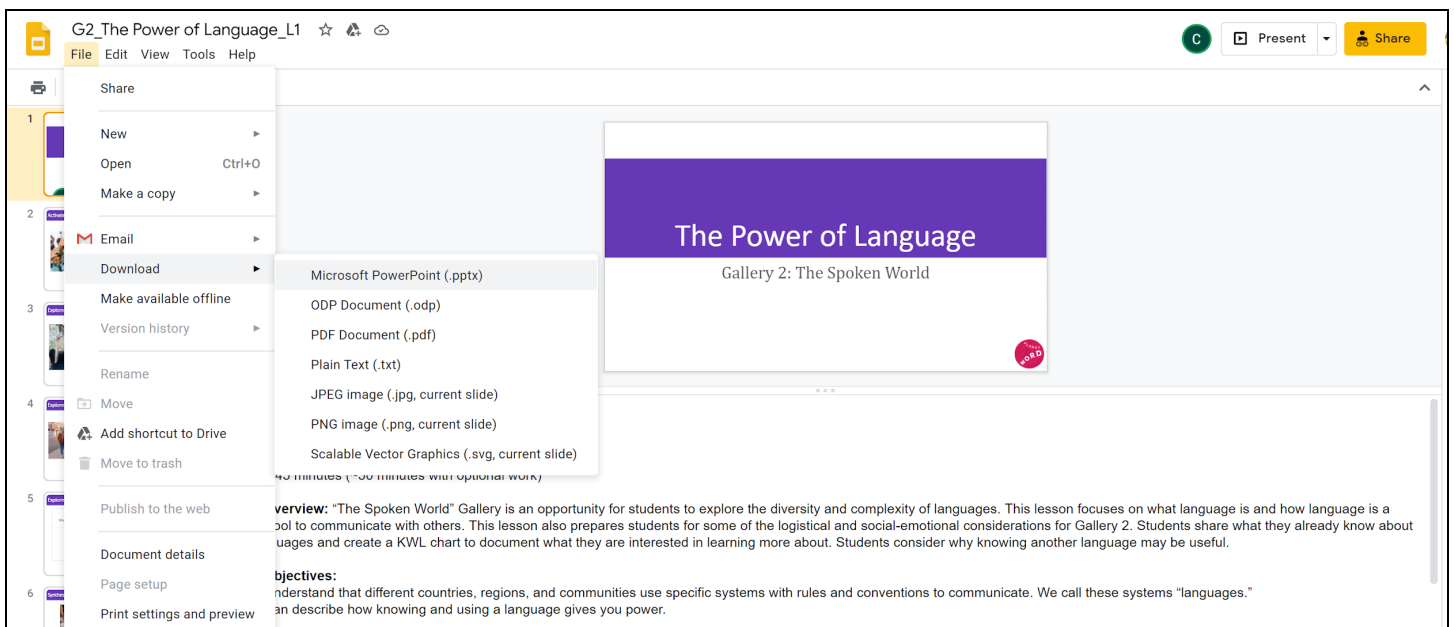
Planet Word Educator lessons are presented in ready-to-go Google Slides format, and are easily customized to meet your students' needs. Here are some tips to help you get started.

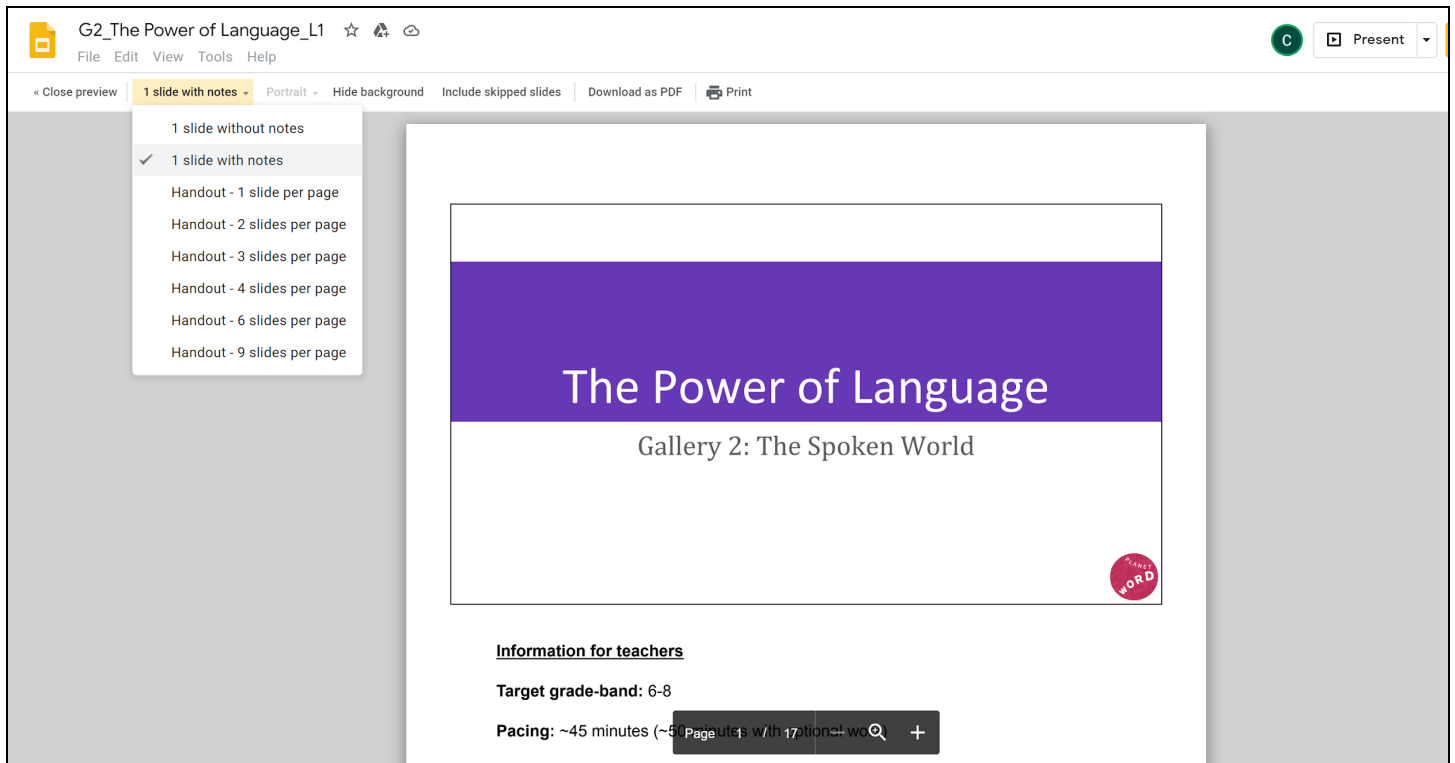
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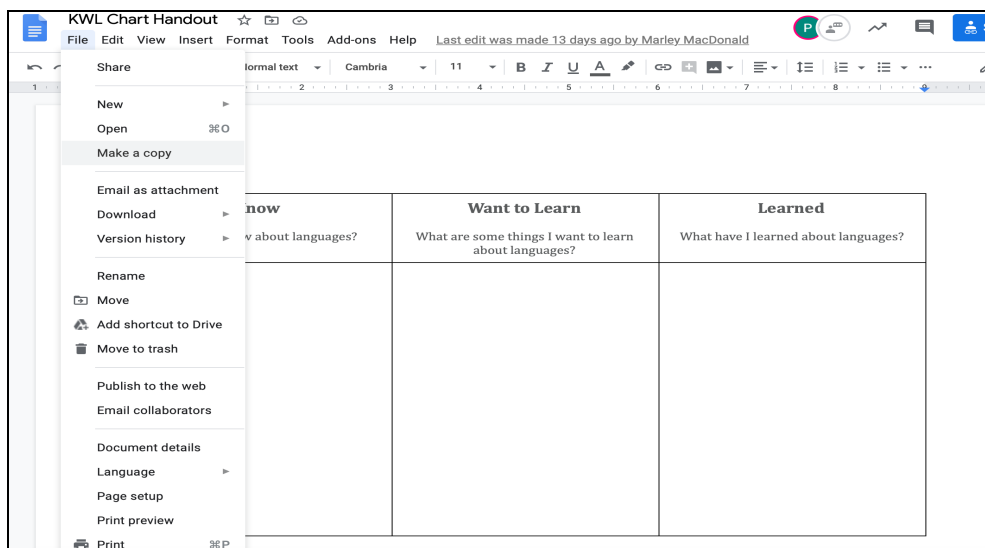
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
