Setting up your child's iPad for school

These instructions will show you how to set up your child's iPad for school. After this setup, all that remains is connecting the iPad to the school network, which will be done at school.

Part of this process involves setting a passcode that will provide some protection against your child accidentally changing the iPad's settings or adding and removing apps. You will have to add and remove apps as required for your child. Please note that if you forget this passcode staff at school cannot assist with unlocking the iPad, therefore please keep this passcode in a safe place.

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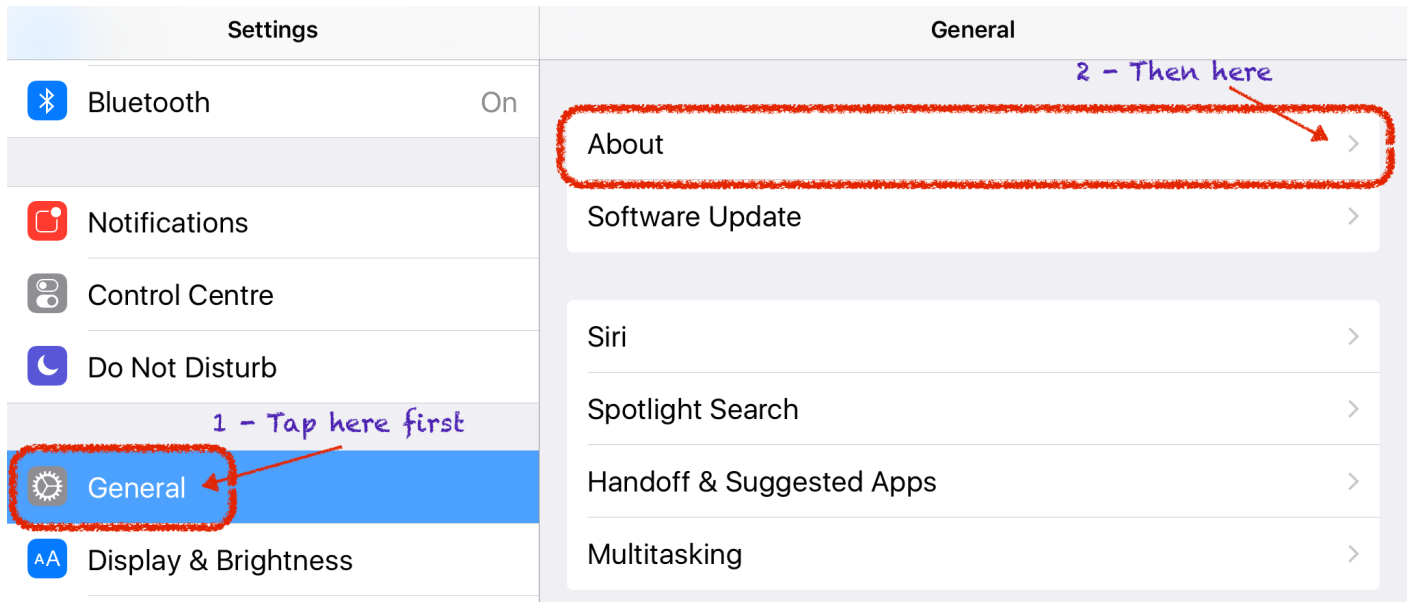
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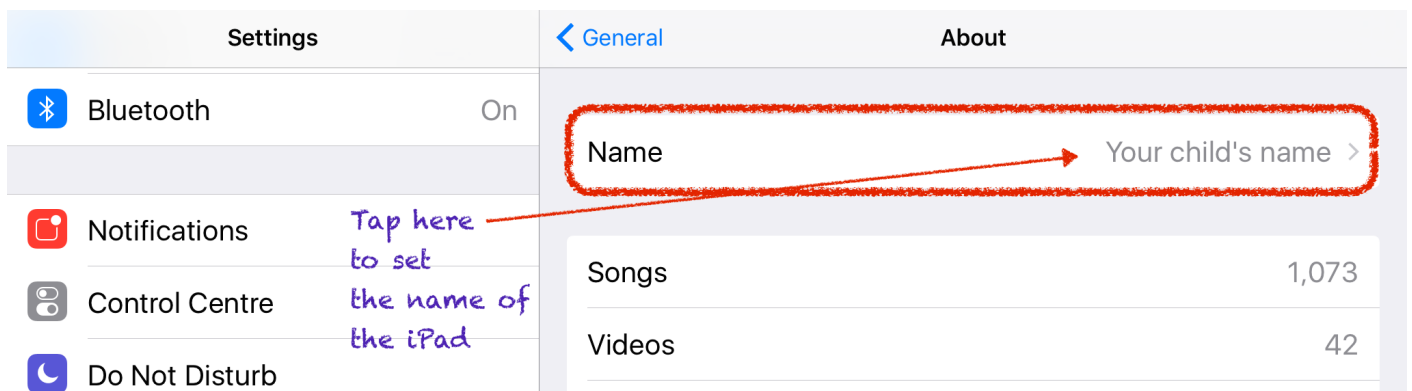
Naming the iPad

Please clearly label your child's iPad, both the device itself and any cover or shell that you have for it. Please also name the iPad in Settings:

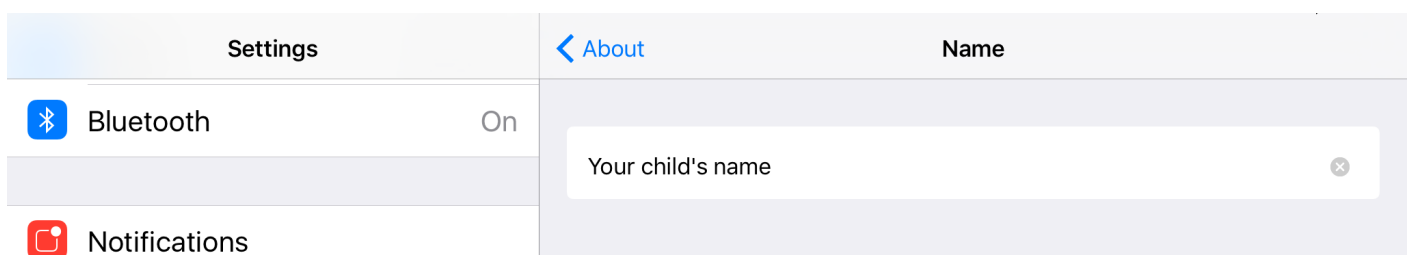
1. Open **Settings** on the home screen
2. Tap **General** in the left-hand list
3. Tap **About** in the right-hand list



4. Tap the **Name** field



5. Type your child's name and class in the box



6. Tap **< About** to save and go back.

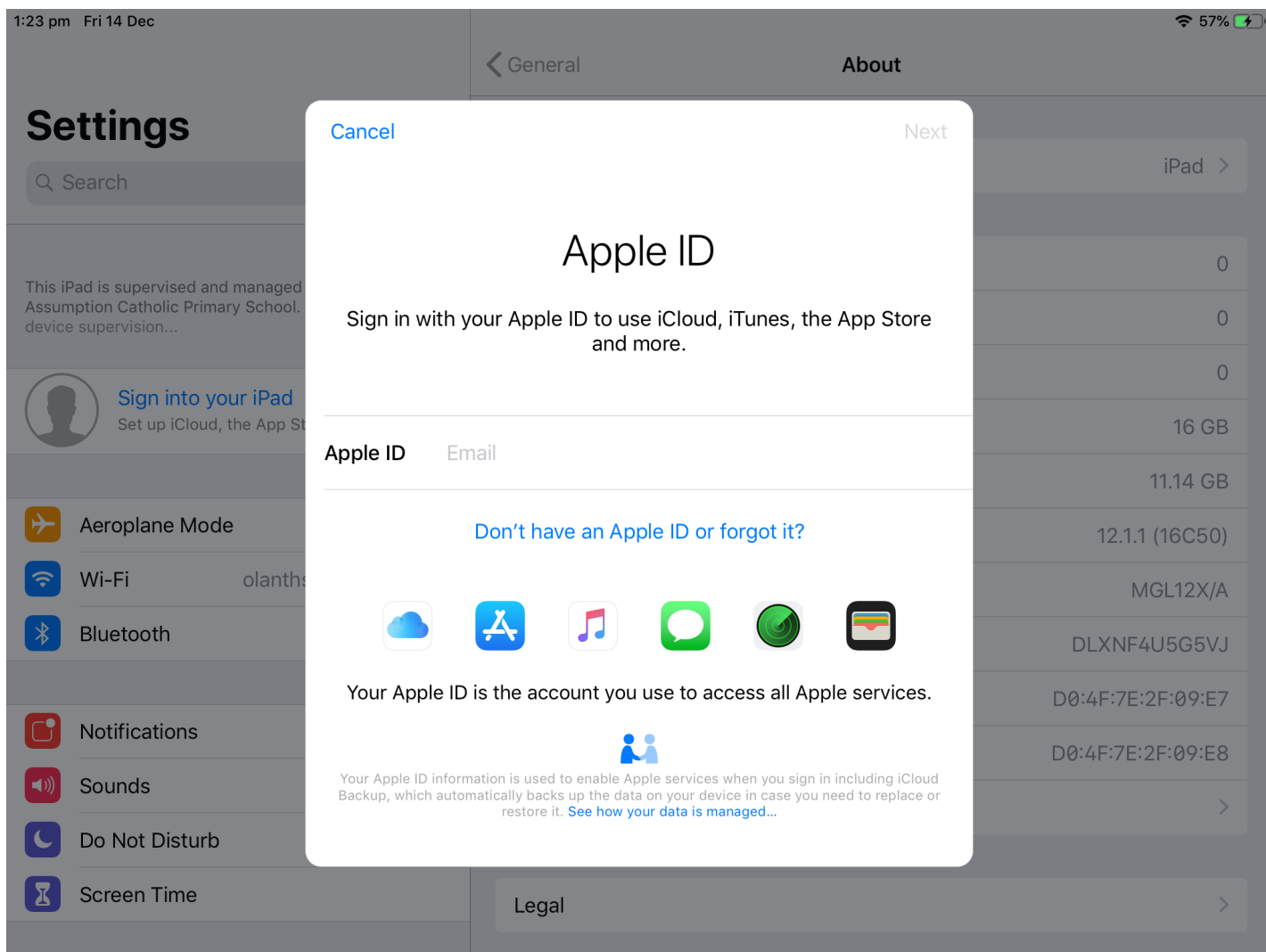
Setting up Family Sharing

[Family Sharing](#) allows you to manage your child's iPad purchases: you can respond to requests for new apps without having to log into the device yourself. You approve or decline new app downloads to your child's iPad from your own iCloud-connected device (iPhone, iPad, Mac). To use it you will need to set up your Apple ID as the organiser of a Family Sharing family, create an Apple ID for your child, and be signed into iCloud with your Apple ID on another device. If you have already set up Family Sharing for your child, skip to this section: For existing Setups. Otherwise follow the instructions following.

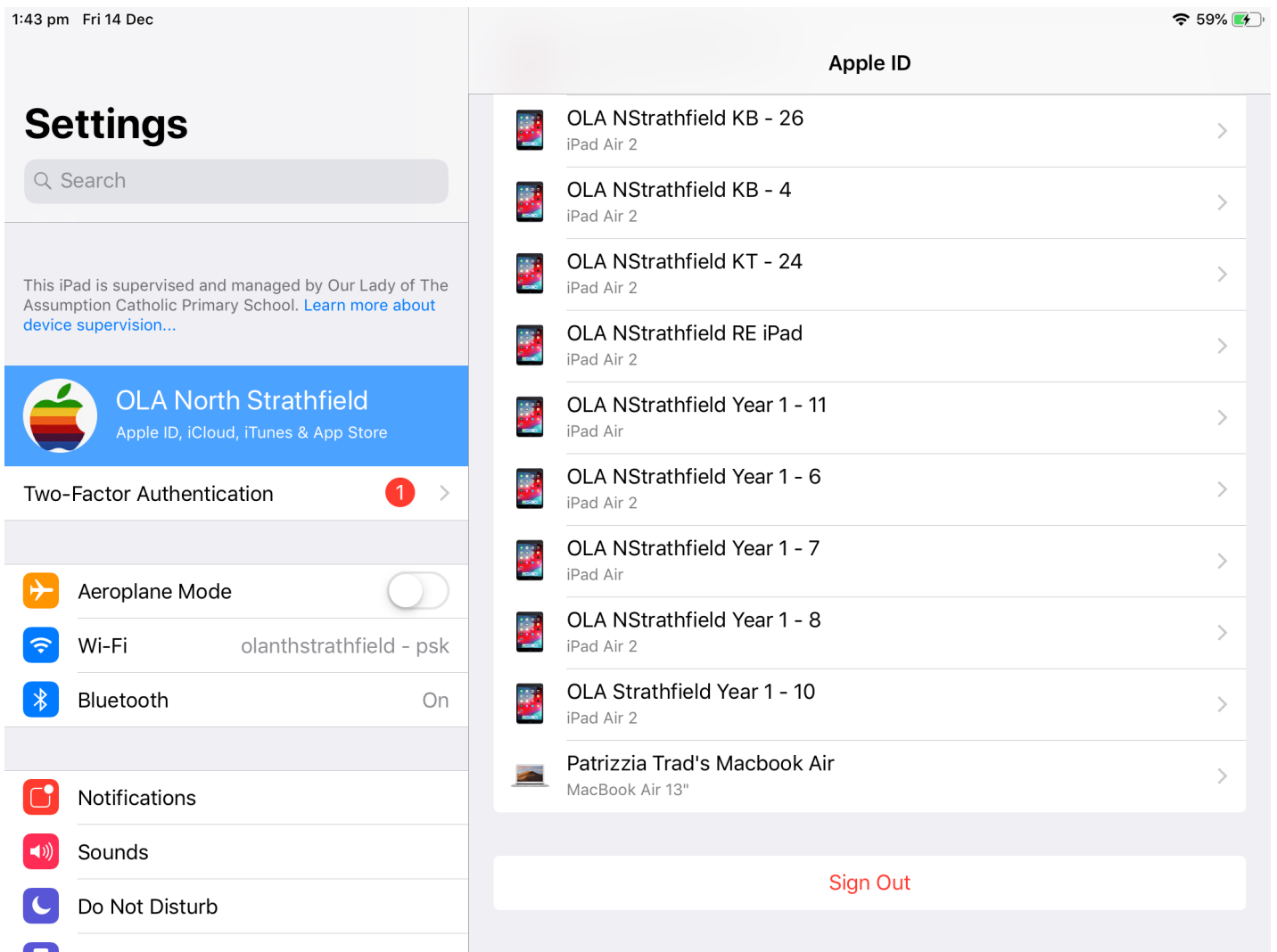
For new Setups

1. Open **Settings** from the home screen
2. Go to **Sign into your iPad** in the left-hand list
3. Sign in with **your** Apple ID (you will create one for your child as part of this process)
 - a. Select "Create a new Apple ID" if you don't have one yet.



4. Once signed in, you can add a family member to Family Sharing.

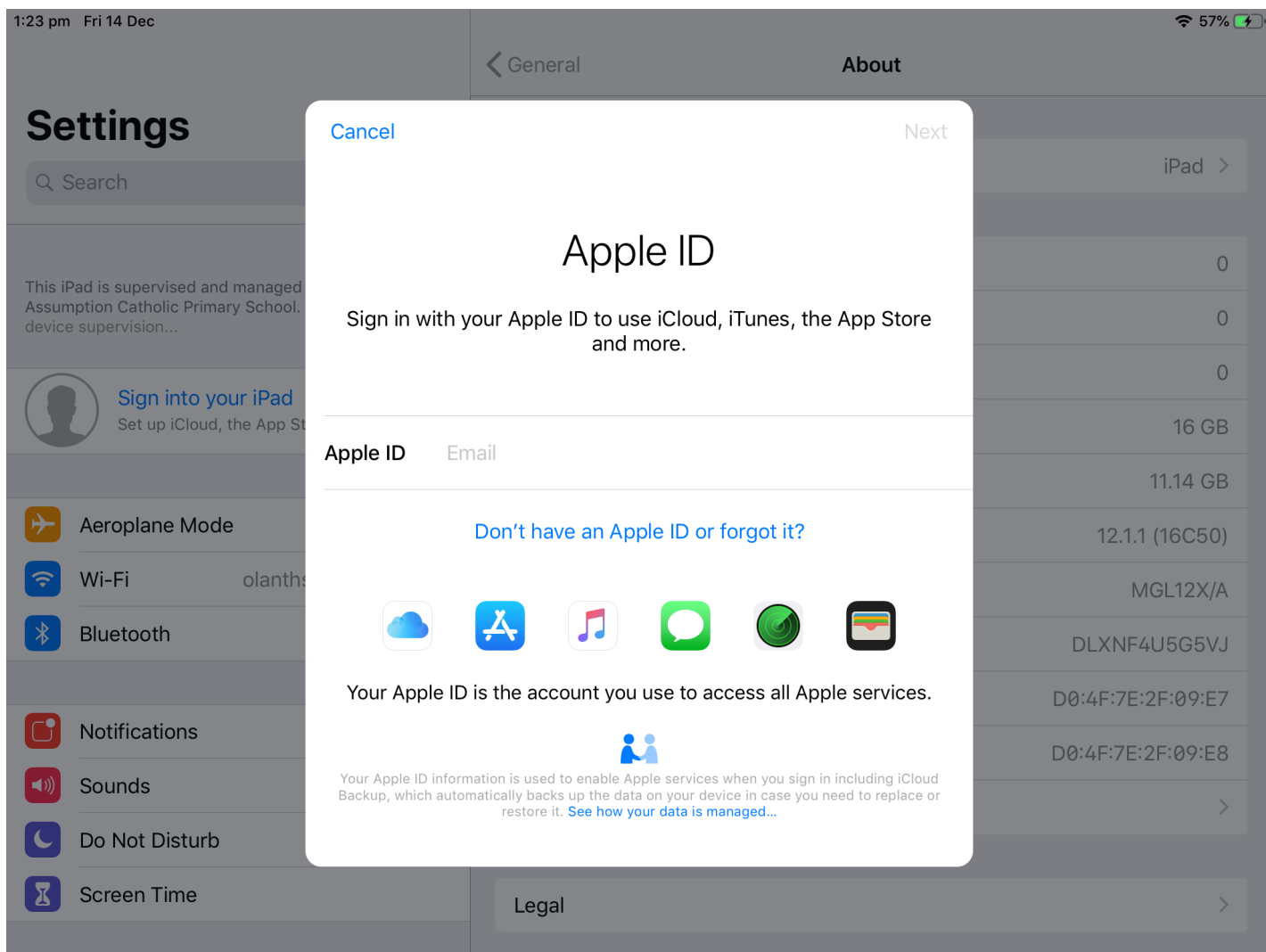
- Follow the on-screen directions to set up a Family Sharing controlled Apple ID for your child.

- When you have finished setting up your child’s Apple ID, sign out of iCloud.



- Continue with the “[For existing Setups](#)” steps

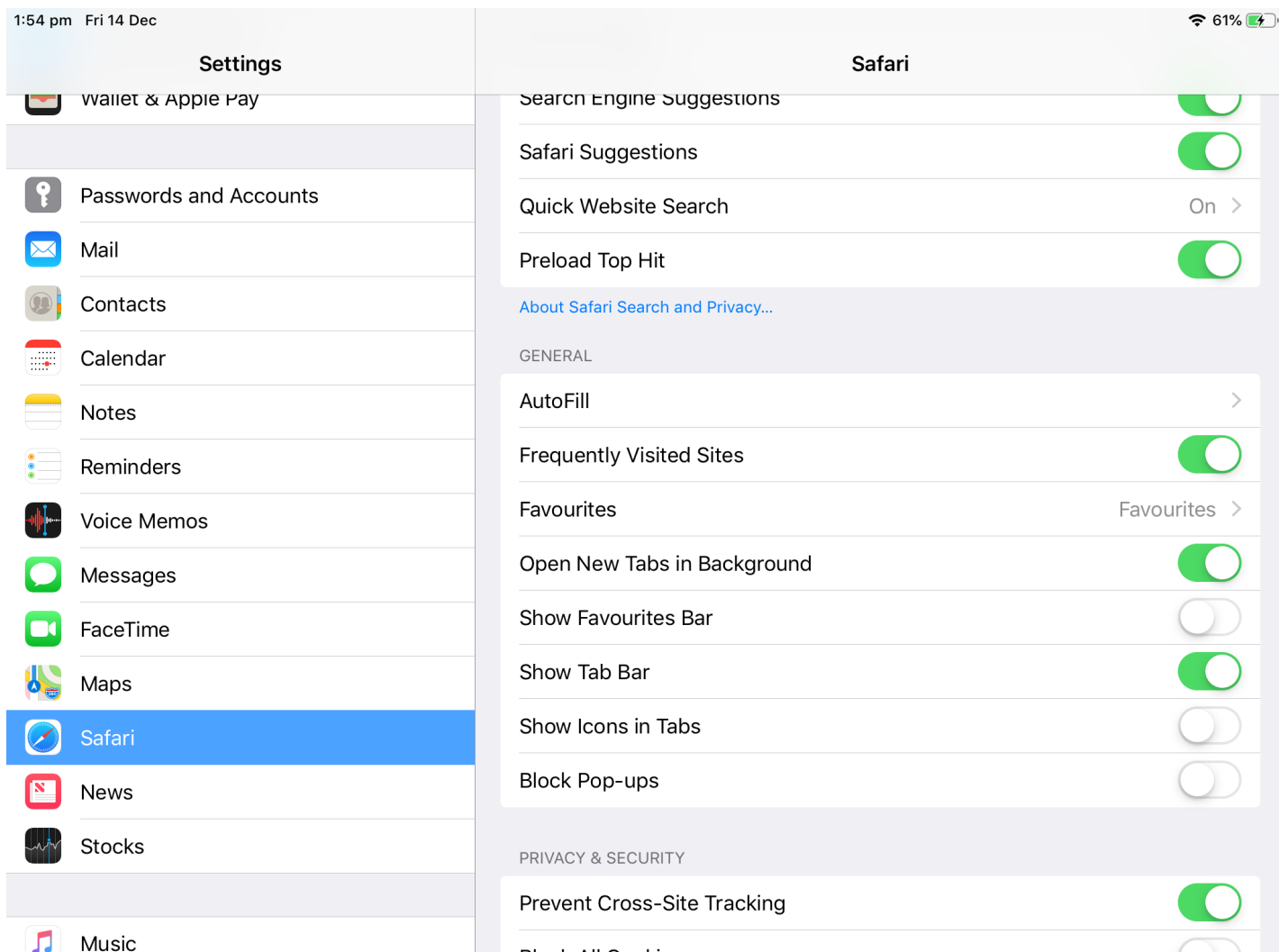
For existing Setups

- Open **Settings** from the home screen
- Go to **Sign into your iPad** in the left-hand list
- Sign in with ***your child’s*** Apple ID set up through Family Sharing



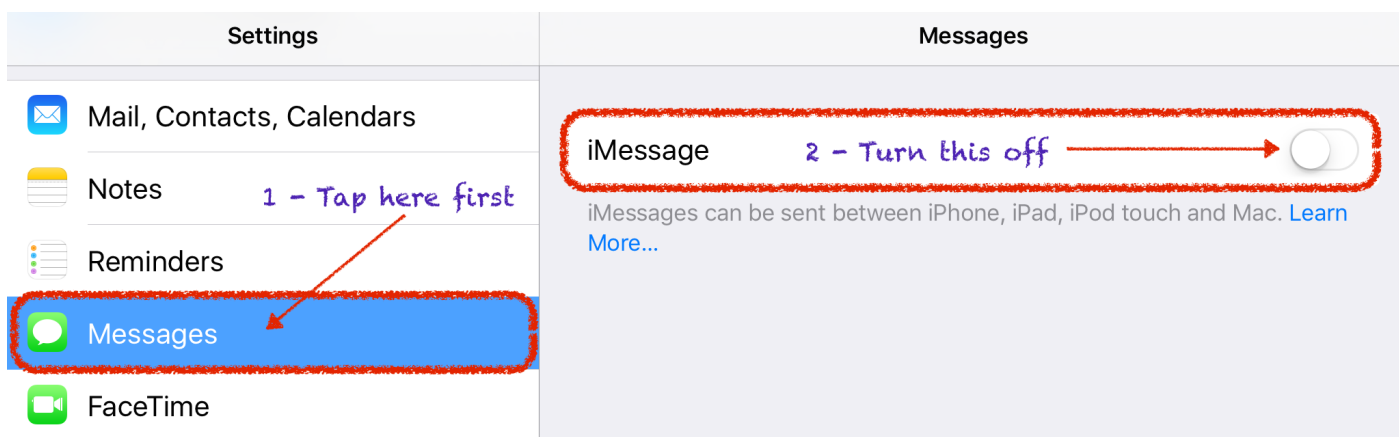
Setting up Safari

1. Open **Settings** from the home screen
2. Go to **Safari** in the left-hand list
3. Scroll down the right-hand list until you can see **Block pop-ups**
4. Set **Block pop-ups** to **OFF**



Turning off iMessage

1. Open **Settings** from the home screen
2. Go to **Messages** in the left-hand list
3. Set **iMessage** in the right-hand pane to **OFF**



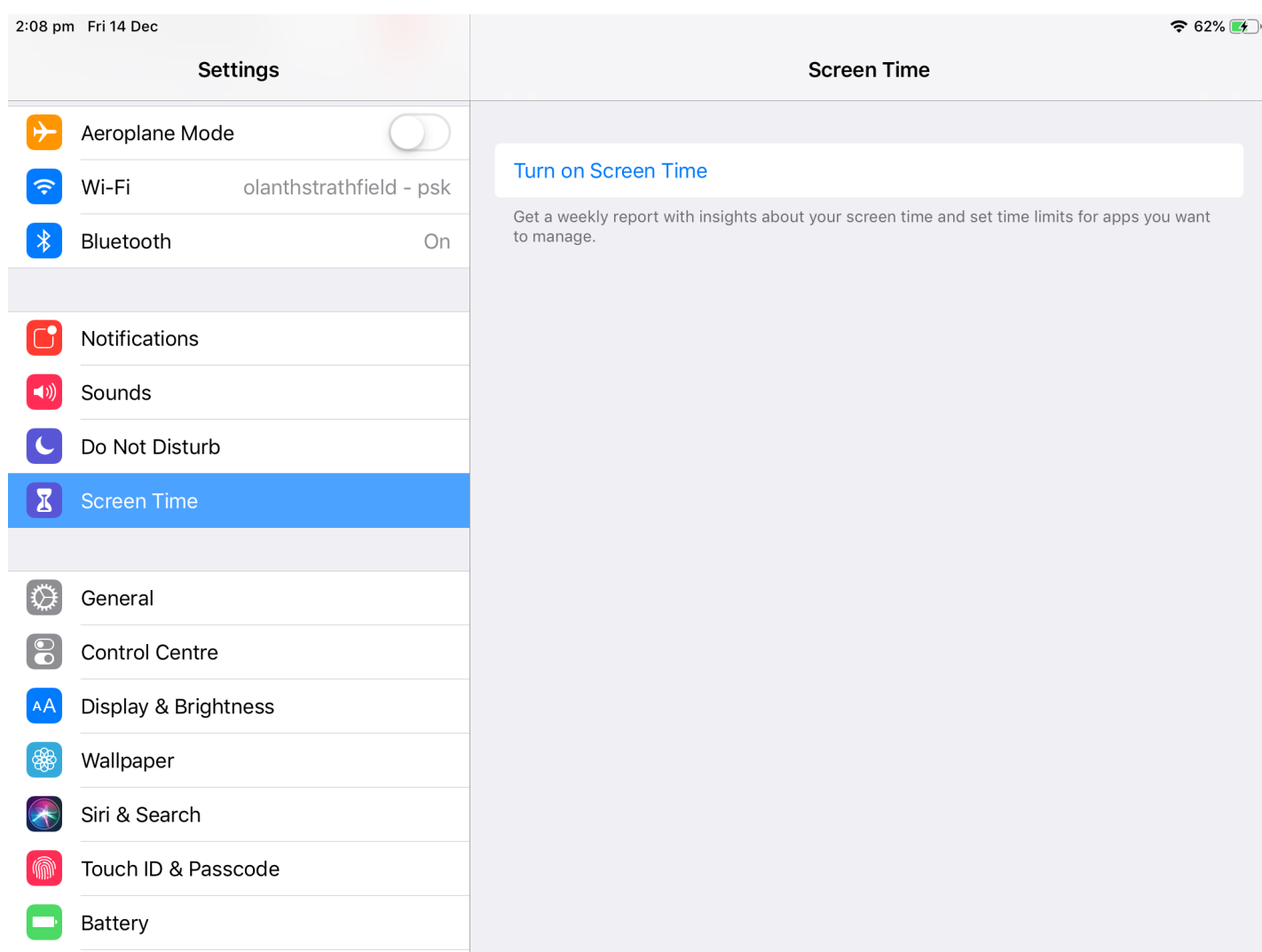
Setting Screen Time

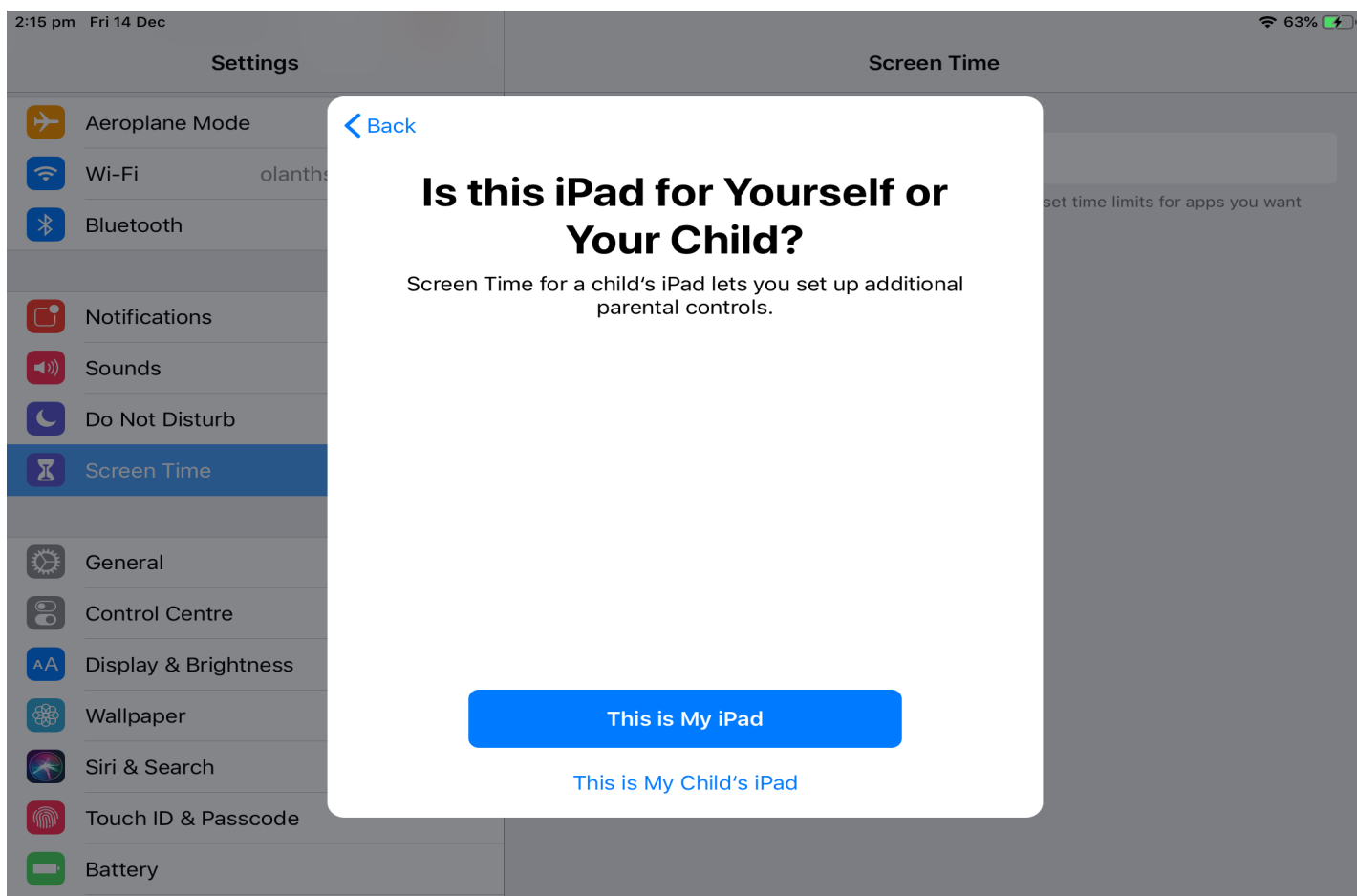
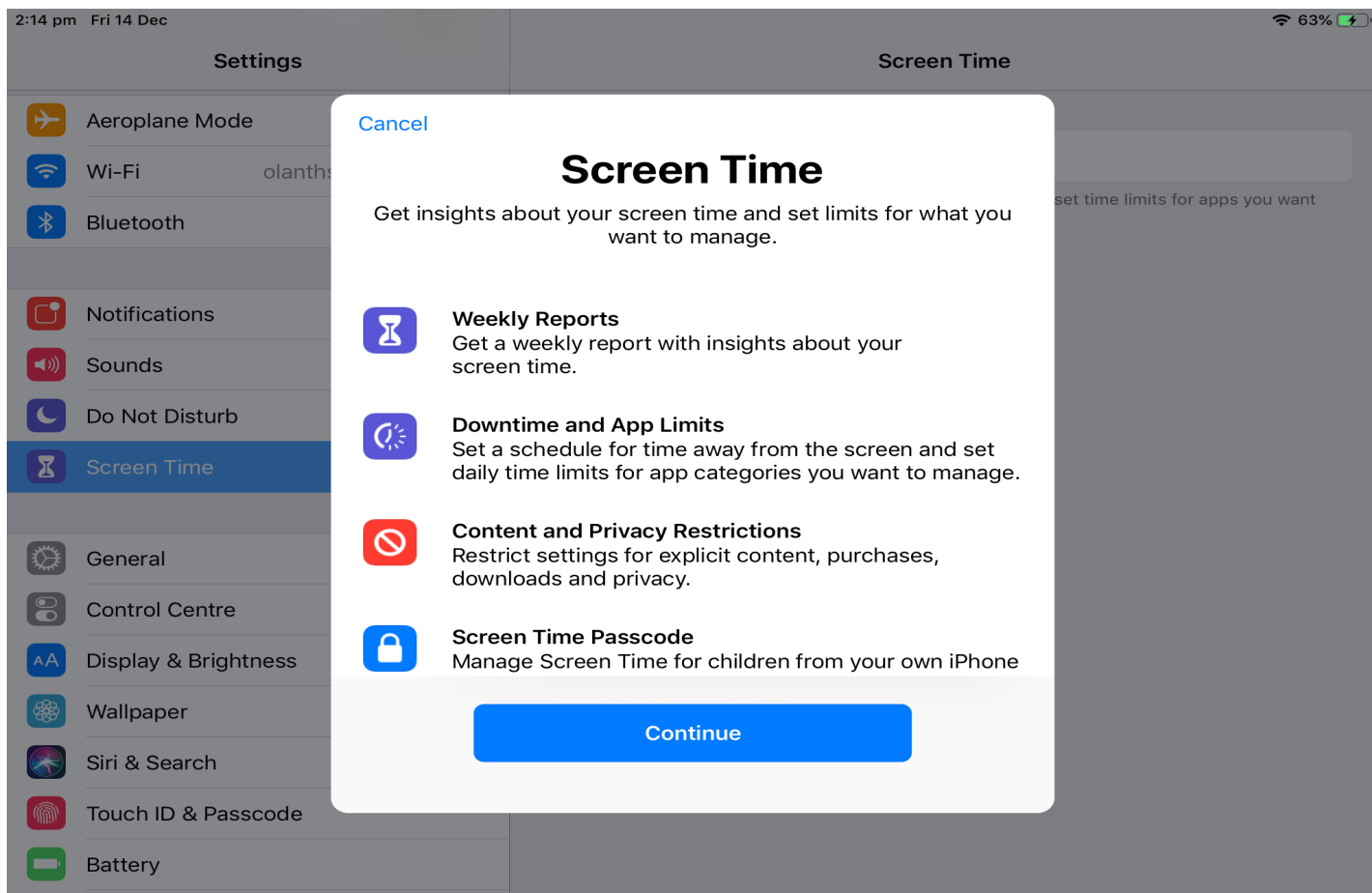
Please note that part of this process sets a **Screen Time Passcode** to provide some protection against the

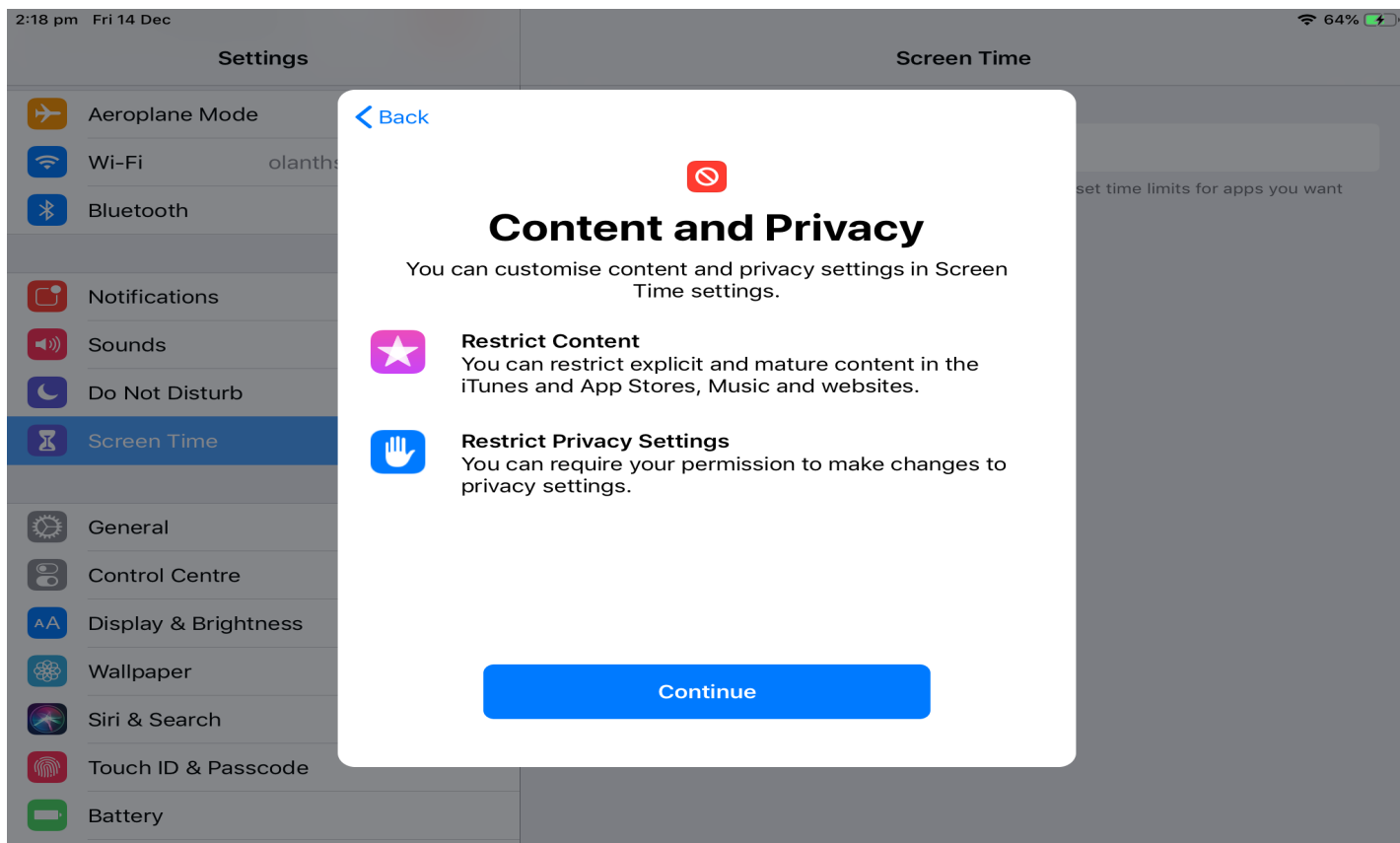
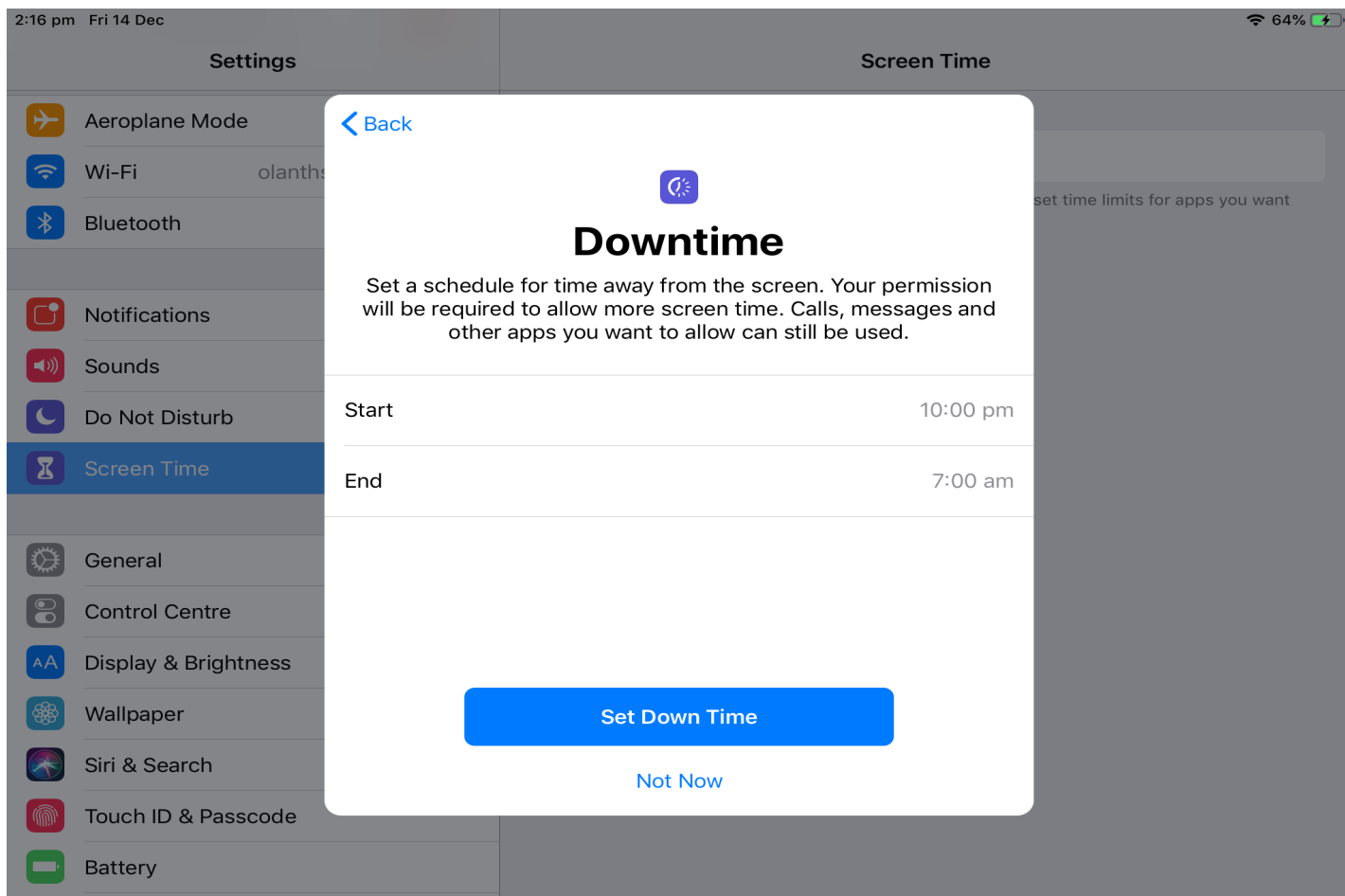
iPad's setting being changed accidentally. Your child will also be blocked from installing and removing apps. Only people who know the passcode can change the iPad's settings and install new apps. School staff cannot recover the passcode if you forget it, so please record it and keep it in a safe place.

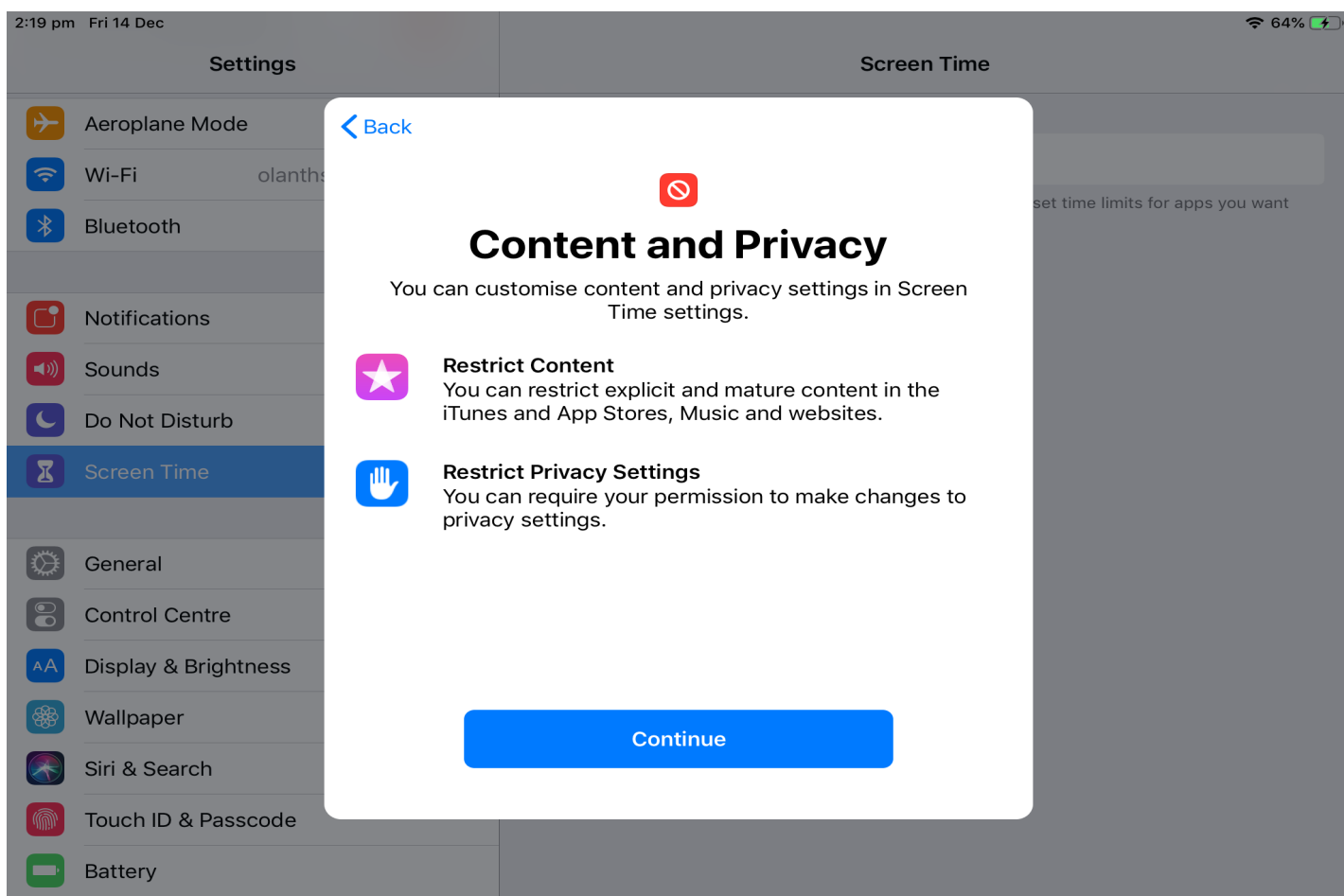
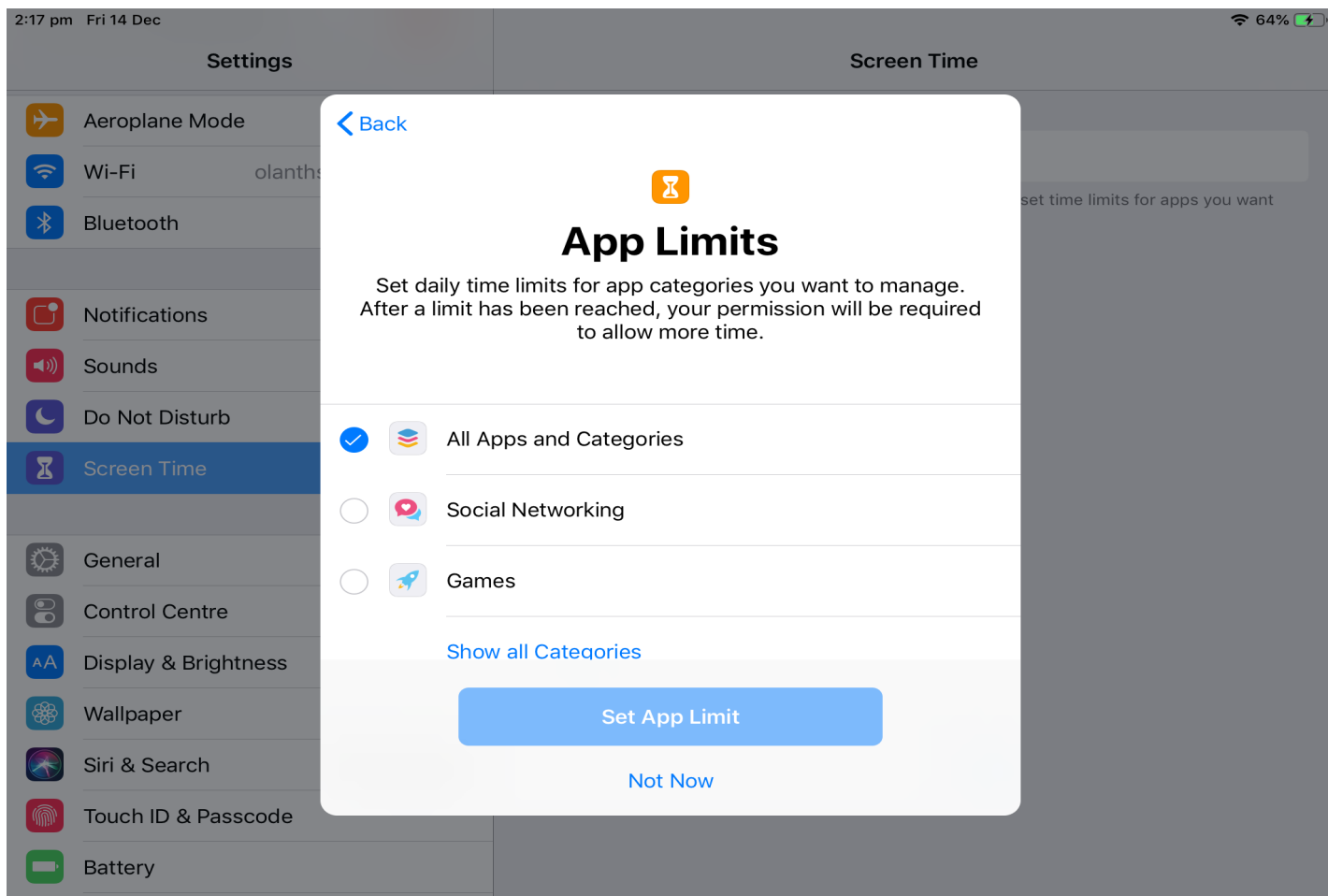
All of the following steps are done in the **Screen Time** area of the **Settings** app.

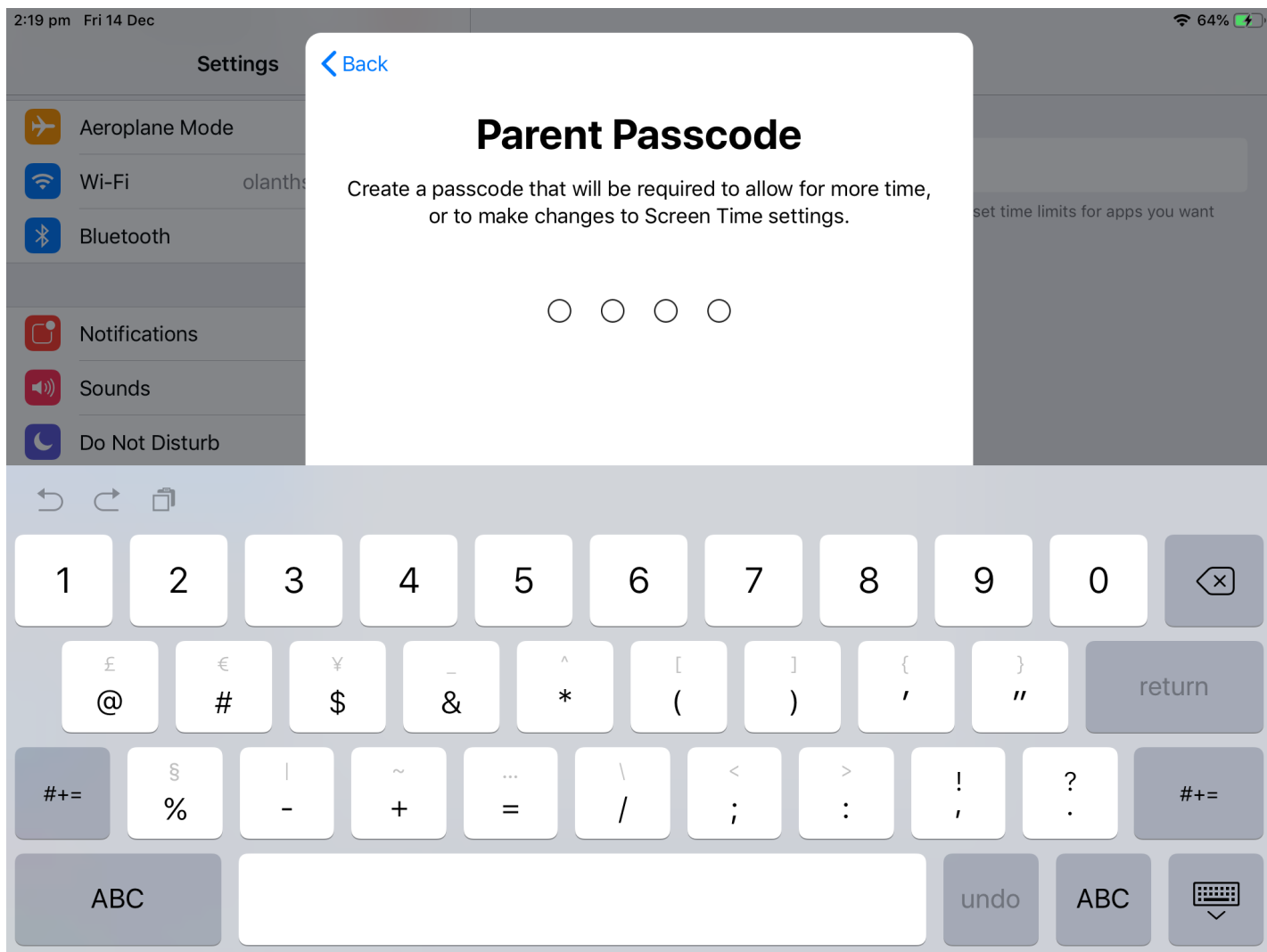
1. Tap **Screen Time** from the **Settings**
2. Tap **Turn on Screen Time**
3. Read the info
4. Select **This is My Child's iPad**
5. Select **Not Now** for following screen (or you can set it up)
6. Tap **Continue** on **Content and Privacy** screen









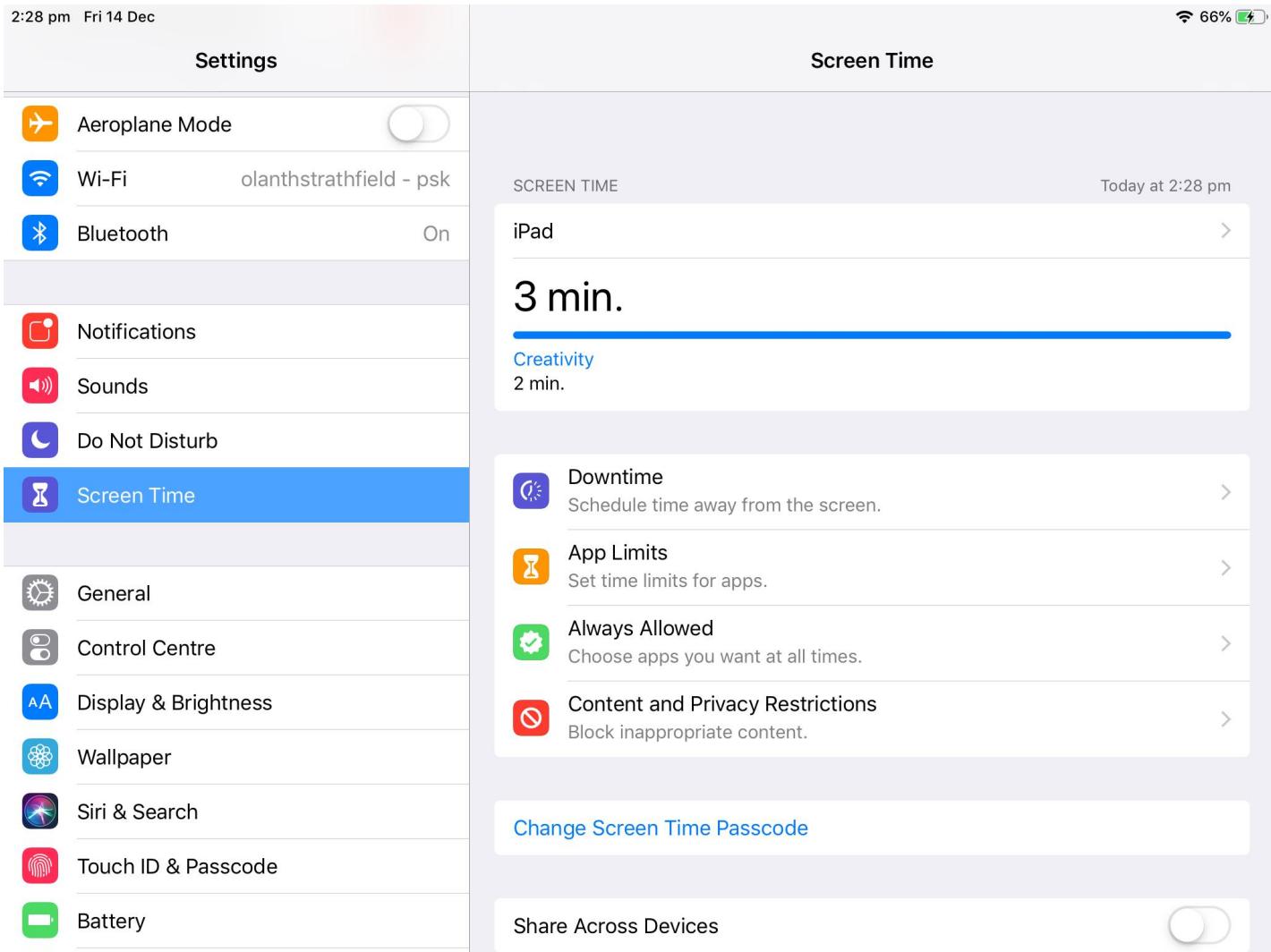


Turning on Screen Time

Before you begin, choose a 4-digit passcode that will be the **Screen Time Passcode**. Take a note of this passcode and keep it safe: if the code is forgotten, school staff *cannot* assist you with unlocking the iPad.

From the [previous steps](#) you will already be in the **Screen Time** area of **Settings**.

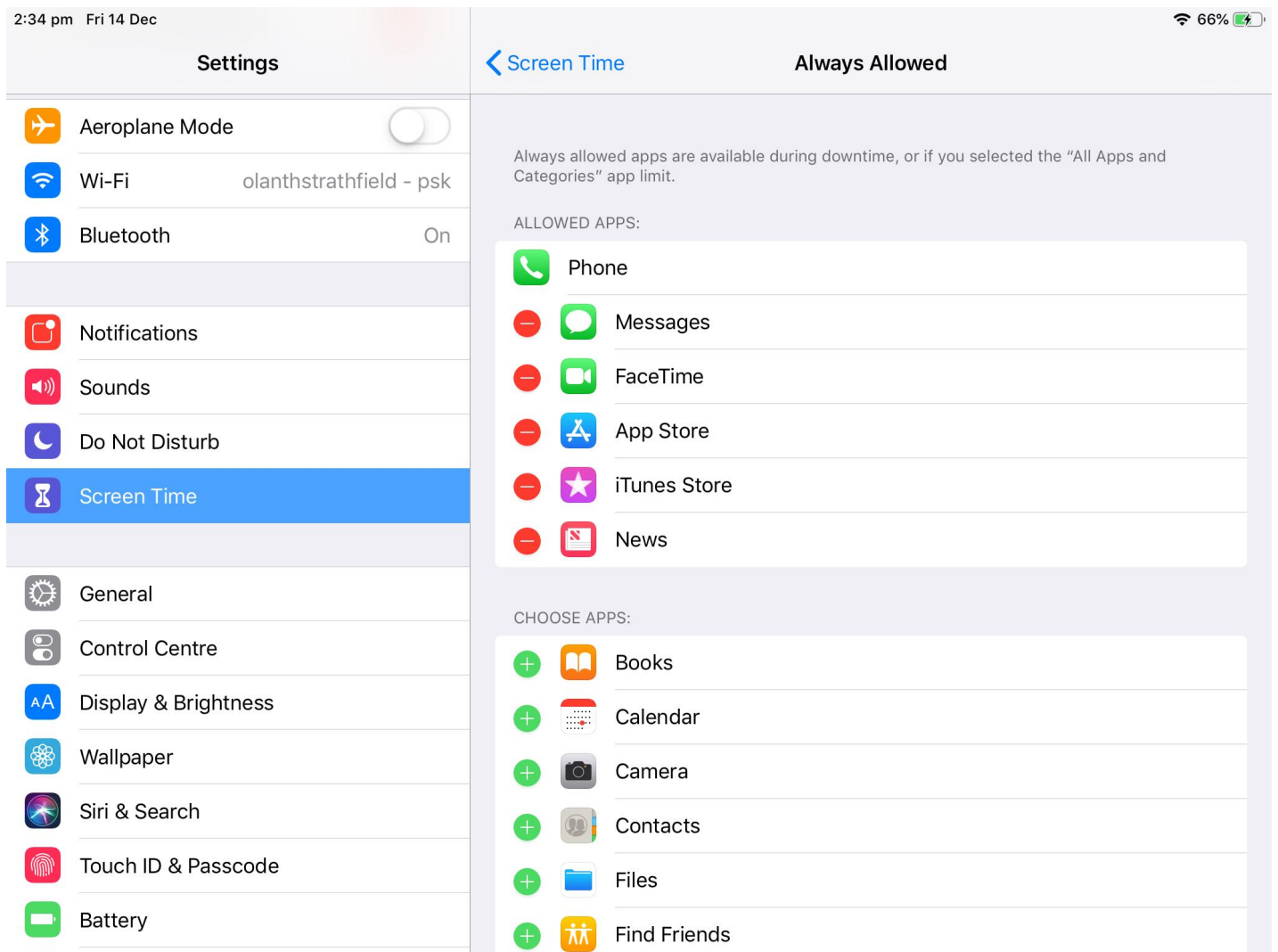
1. Enter the **Parent Passcode** you decided on at the [beginning of this step](#). (Enter it again when the confirmation box appears.)
2. Set up **Downtime**, **App Limits**, **Always Allowed** and **Content and Privacy Restrictions**
3. **Please Be aware that following setting just a suggestion. You can set up whatever more suits your concern.**

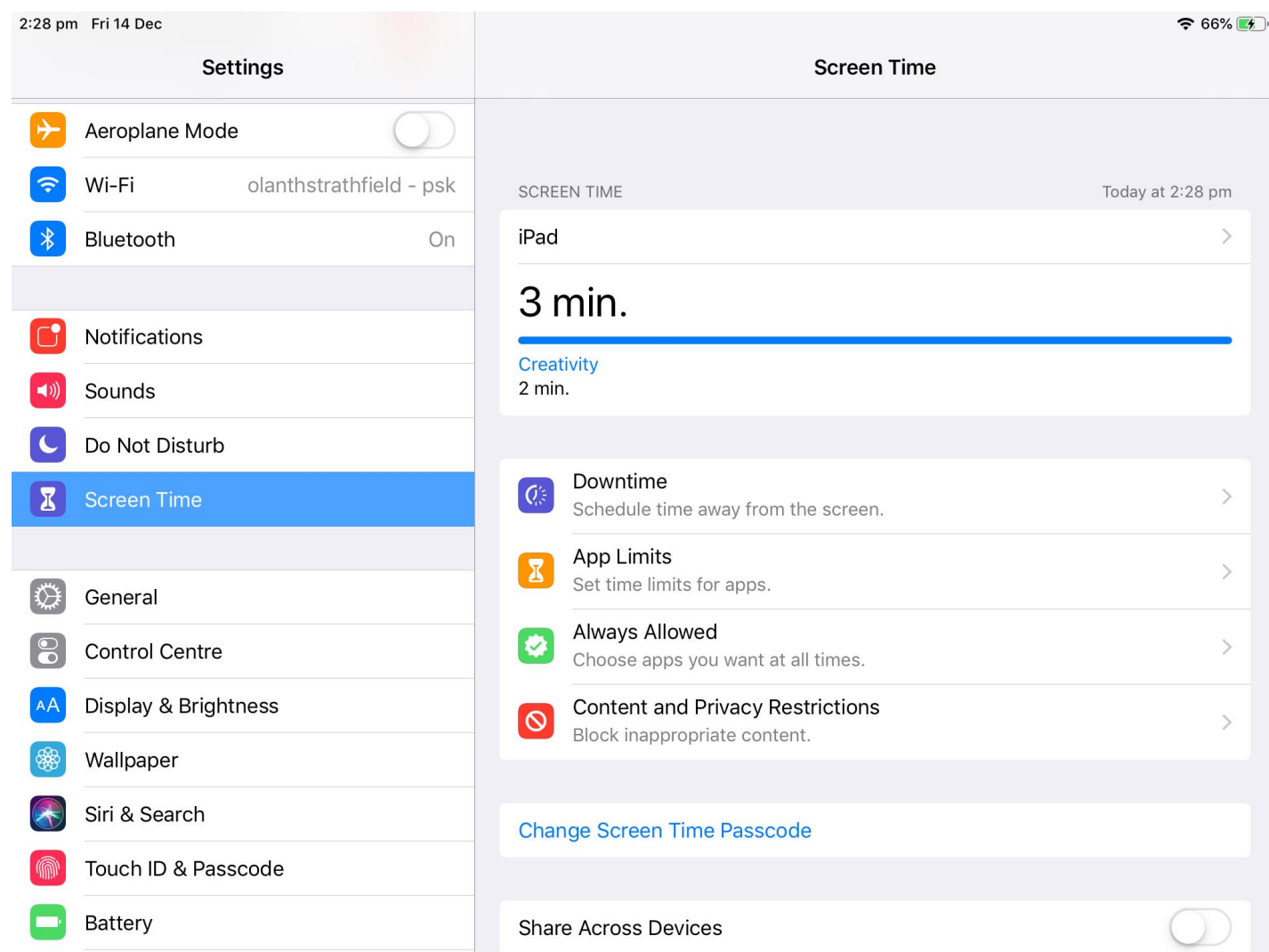
Always Allowed Apps and Services

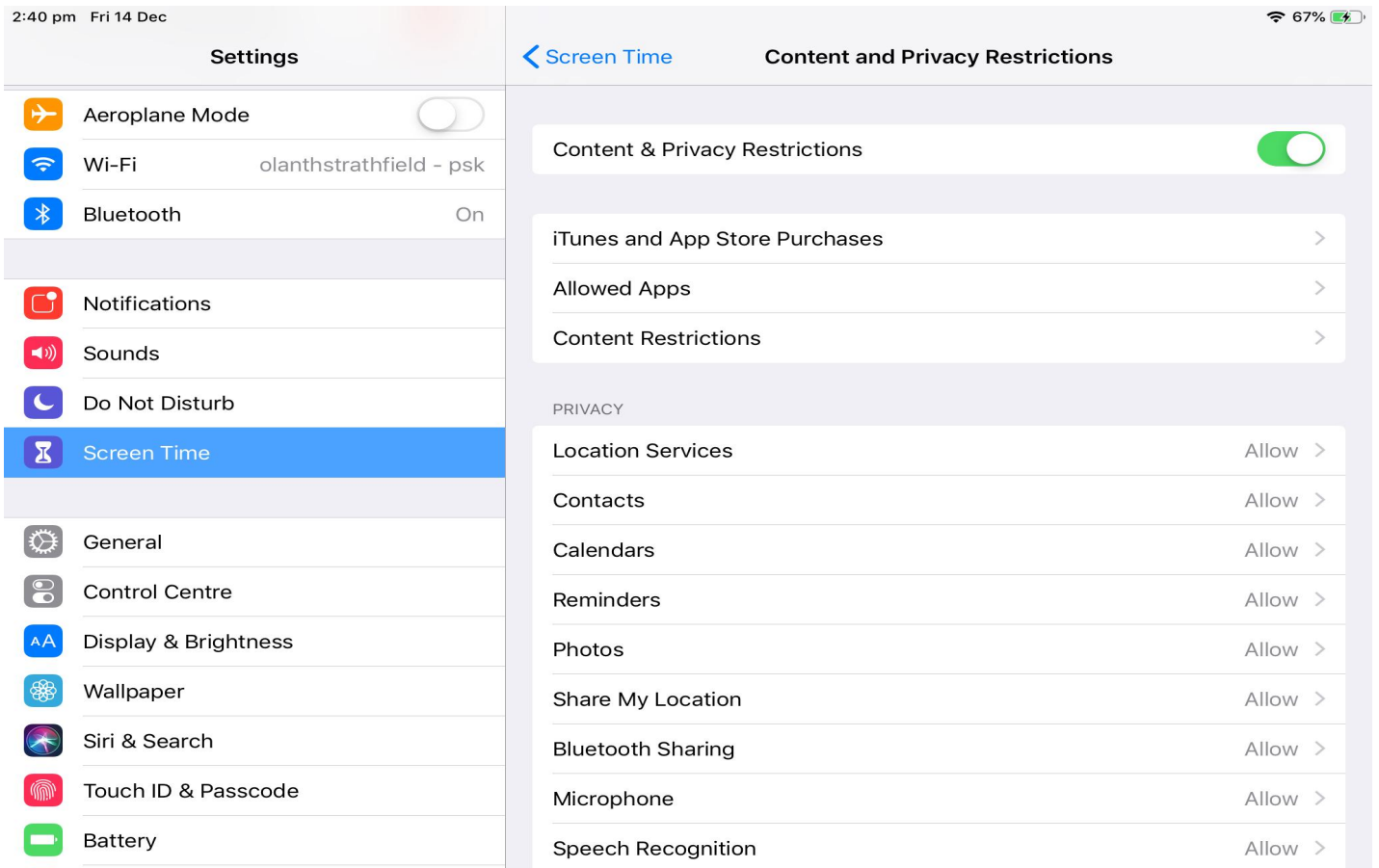
Tap **Always Allowed** then set the following to **ALLOW** these apps and services:



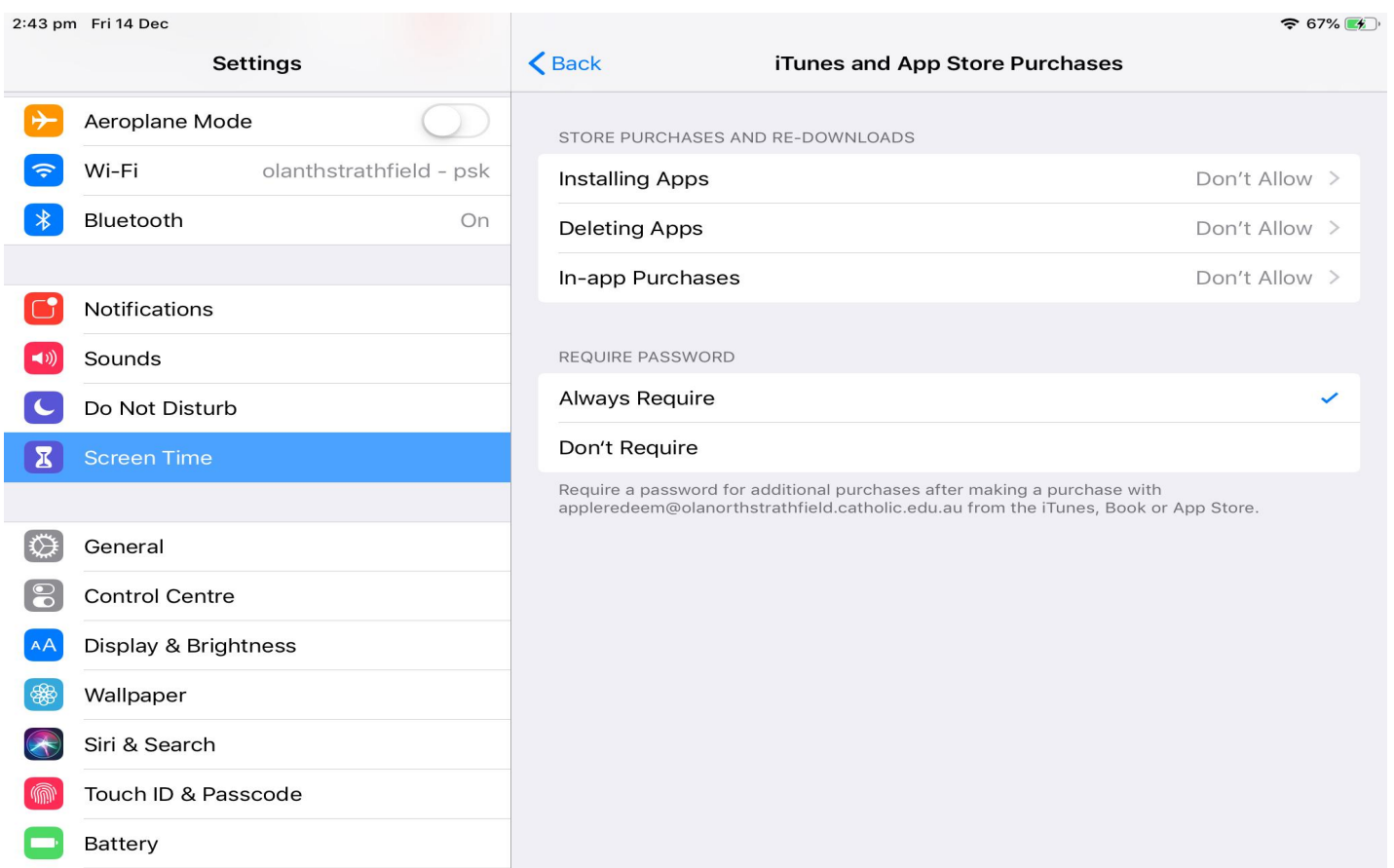
Content and Privacy Restrictions

Tap **Content and Privacy Restrictions**, turn on **Content & Privacy Restrictions**

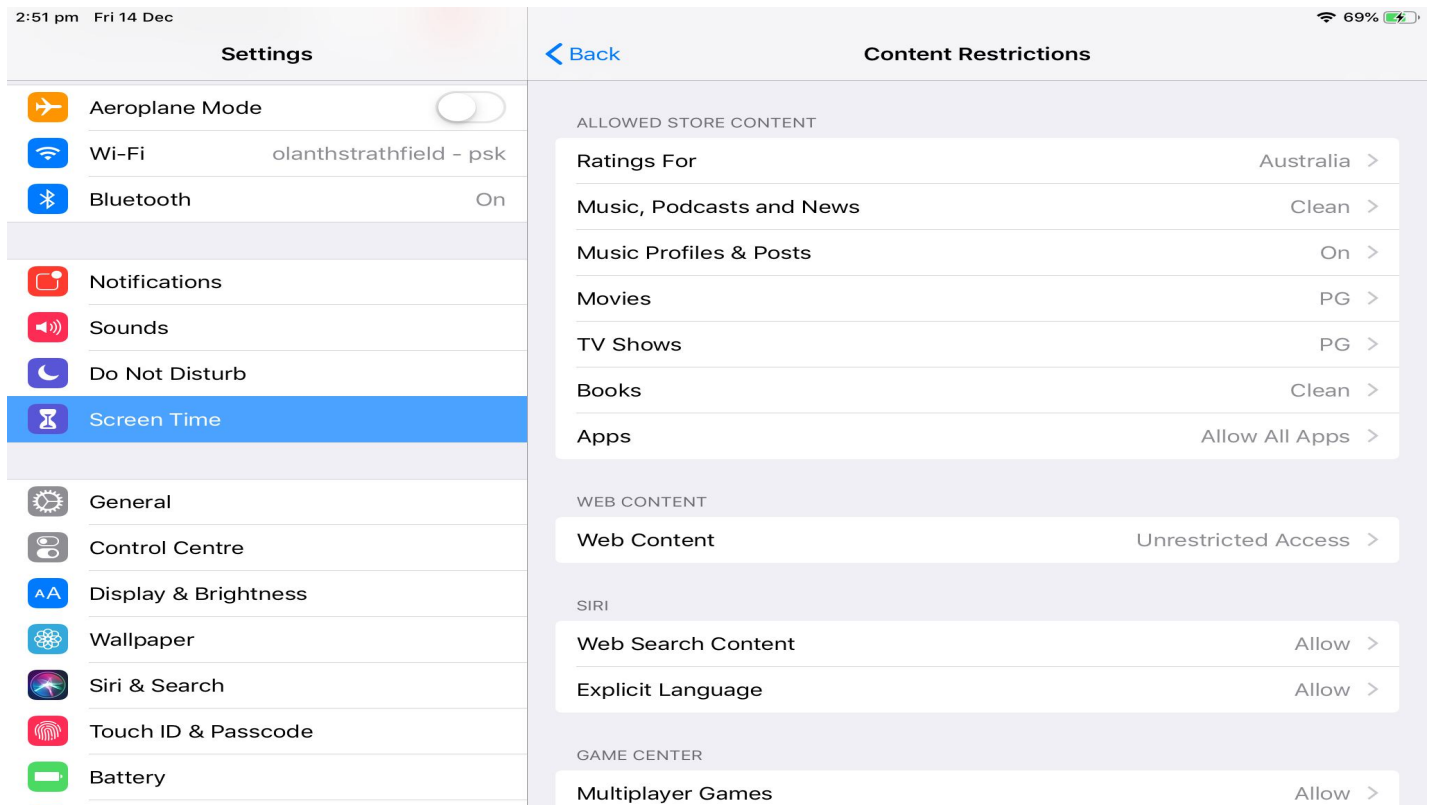




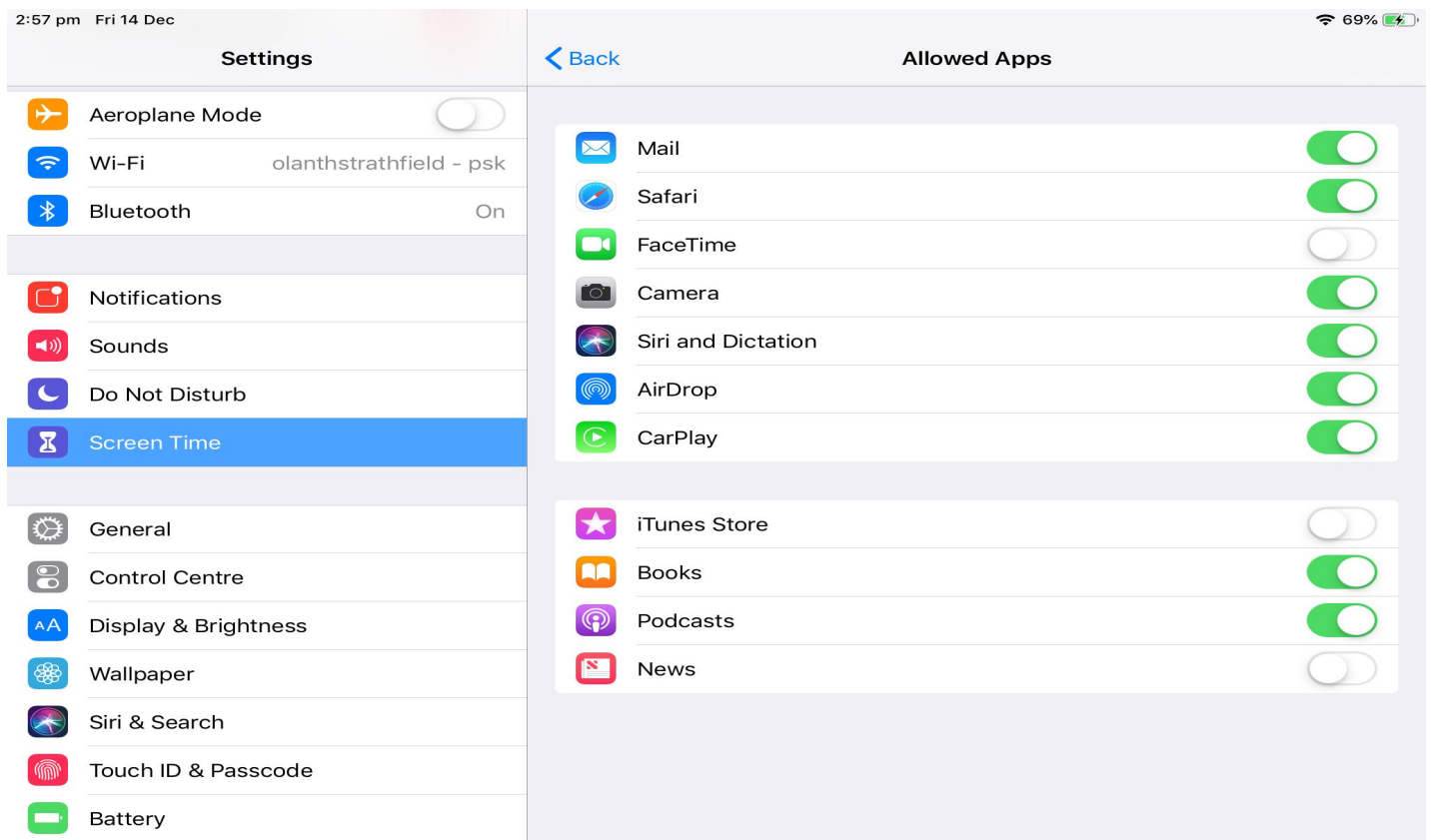
Tap **iTunes and App Store Purchases**. Set it as below



Tap Content Restrictions

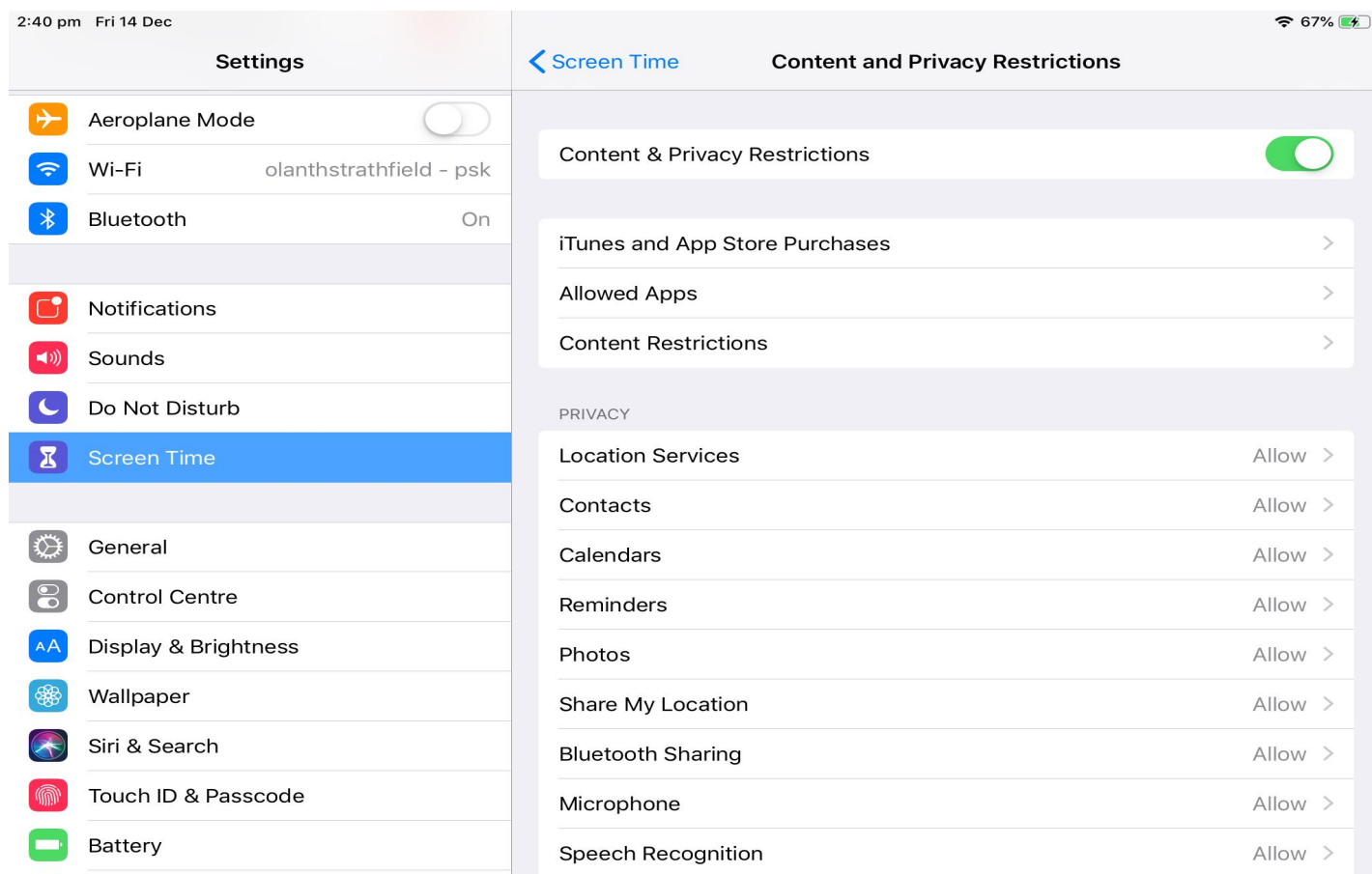


Tap Allowed Apps



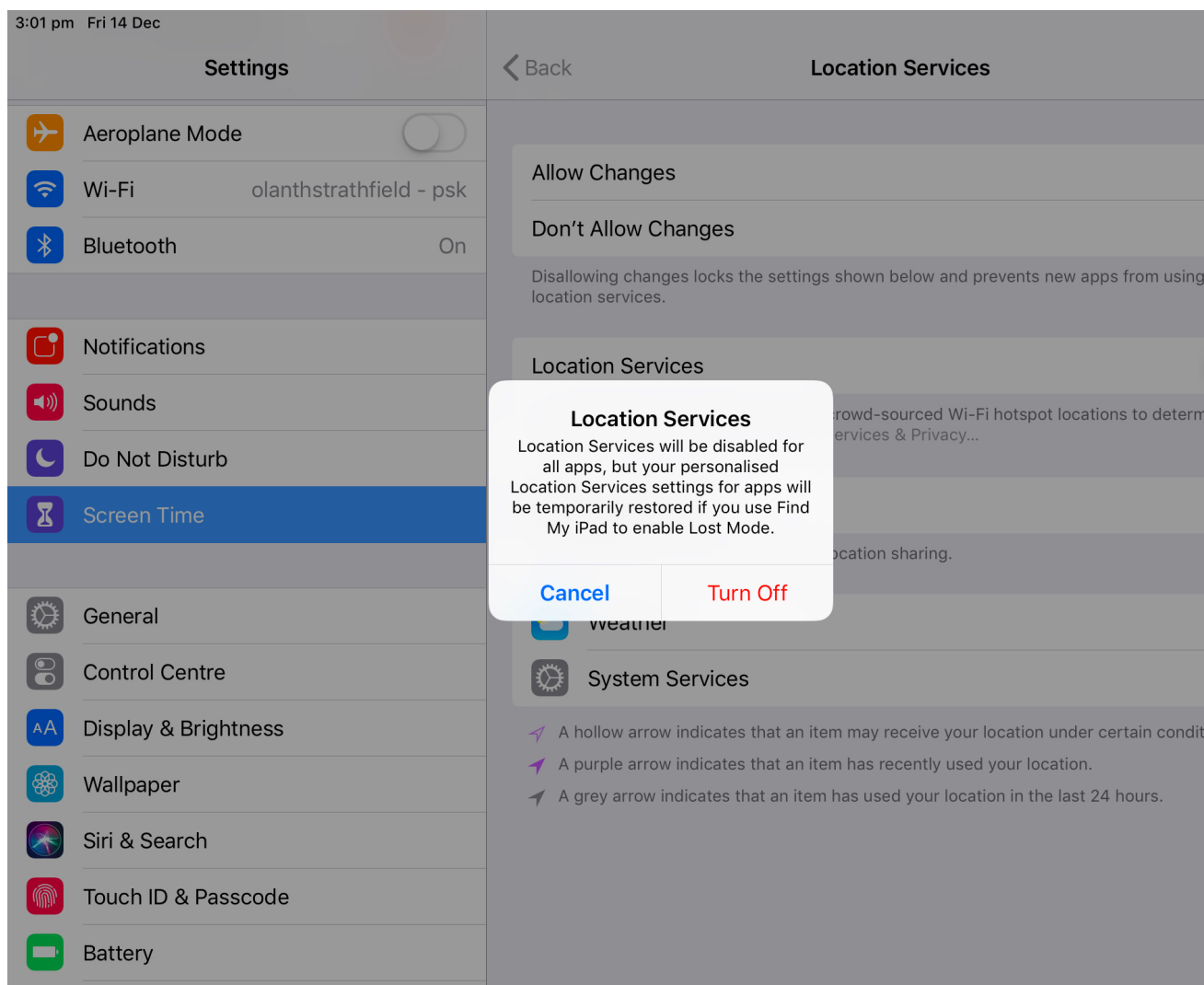
Privacy

Staying in the **Screen Time** area scroll down to the **PRIVACY** pane.

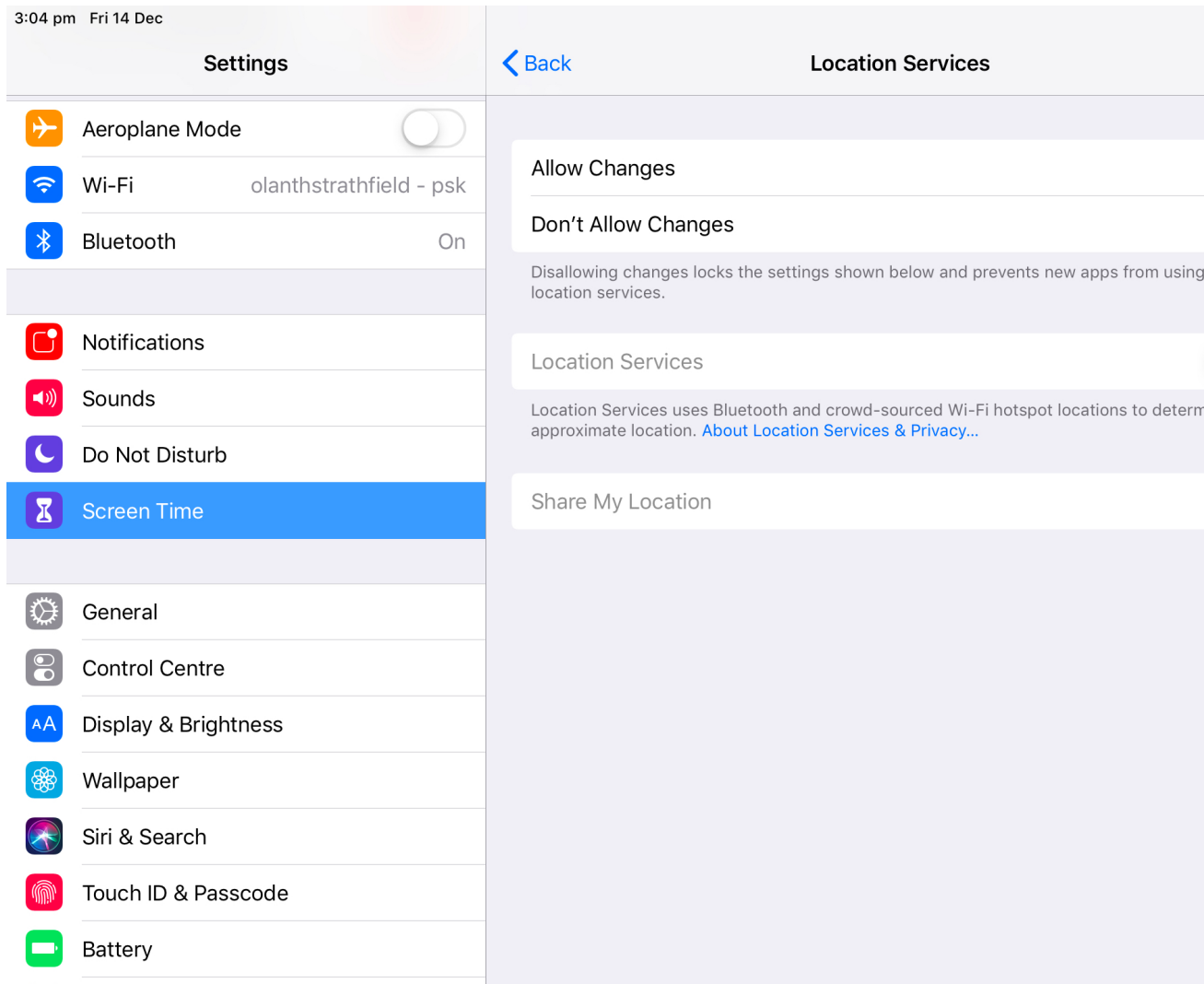


1. Location Services

- 1.1. Tap **Location Services** — you will immediately see the “Location Services” dialog box
- 1.2. Tap **Turn Off**



- 1.3. Now that Location Services is turned off, tap “Don’t Allow Changes” to set the restriction



2. **Contacts**

- 2.1. Tap **Contacts**
- 2.2. Tap “Don’t Allow Changes” to set the restriction

3. **Calendars**

- 3.1. Tap **Calendars**
- 3.2. Tap “Allow Changes” to allow apps to request access to calendars

4. Reminders

4.1. Tap **Reminders**

4.2. Tap “Allow Changes” to allow apps to set reminders

5. Photos

5.1. Tap **Photos**

5.2. Tap “Allow Changes” to allow apps to request access to Photos storage

6. Share My Location

6.1. Tap **Share My Location**

6.2. Tap “Don’t Allow Changes” to set the restriction

7. Bluetooth Sharing

7.1. Tap **Bluetooth Sharing**

7.2. Tap “Allow Changes” to allow apps to request the ability to share data over Bluetooth connections

8. Microphone

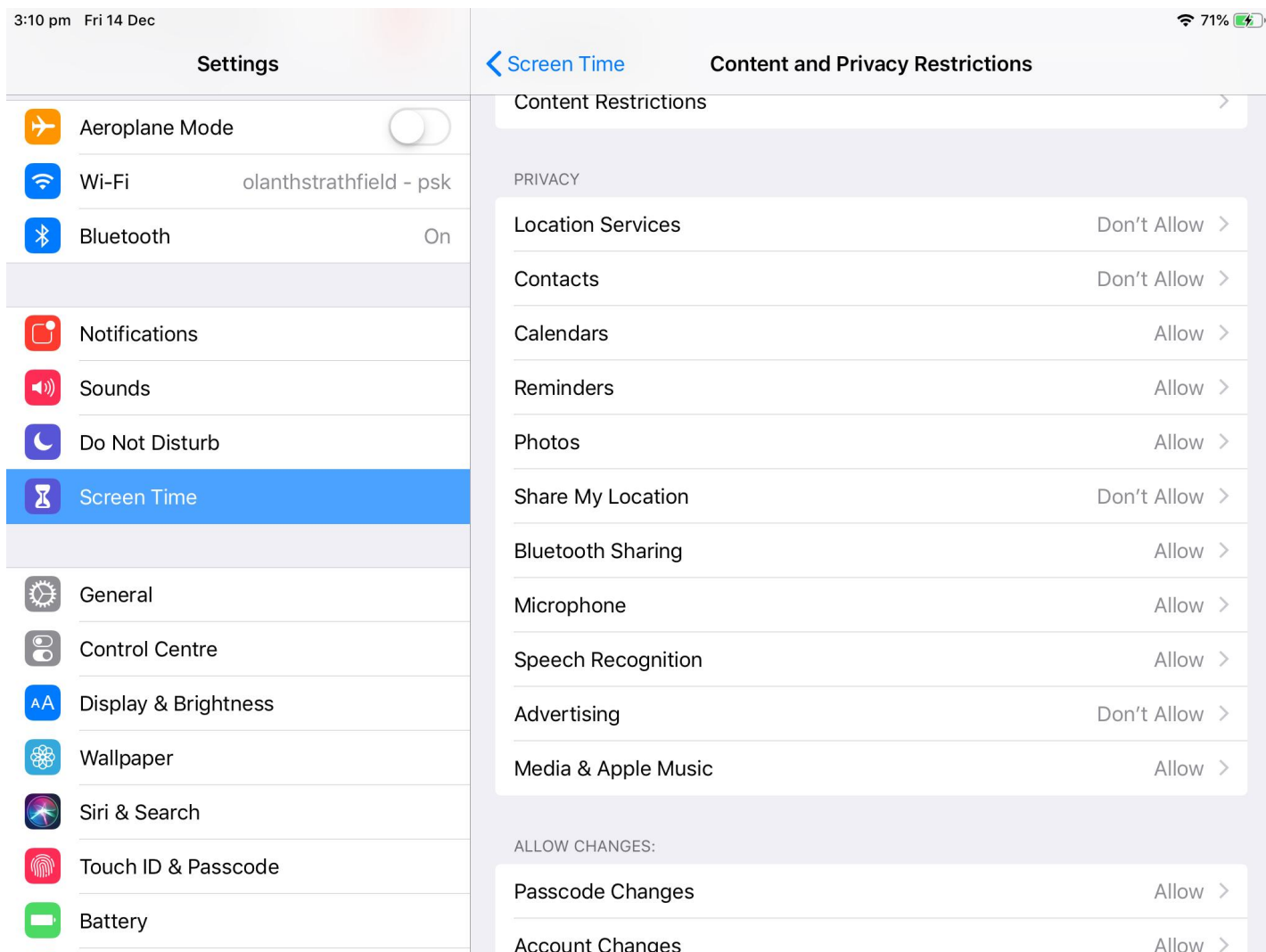
8.1. Tap **Microphone**

8.2. Tap “Allow Changes” to allow apps to request access to the microphone

9. Advertising

9.1. Tap **Advertising**

9.2. Tap “Don’t Allow Changes” to set the restriction



Allow Changes

Note that when this restriction is set your child will not be able to add any email accounts to the iPad. To update or add an email account you will need to enter the [Restrictions Passcode](#) and allow account changes before trying to make the account changes.

Staying in the **Screen Time** area, scroll down to the **ALLOW CHANGES** pane.

1. Accounts

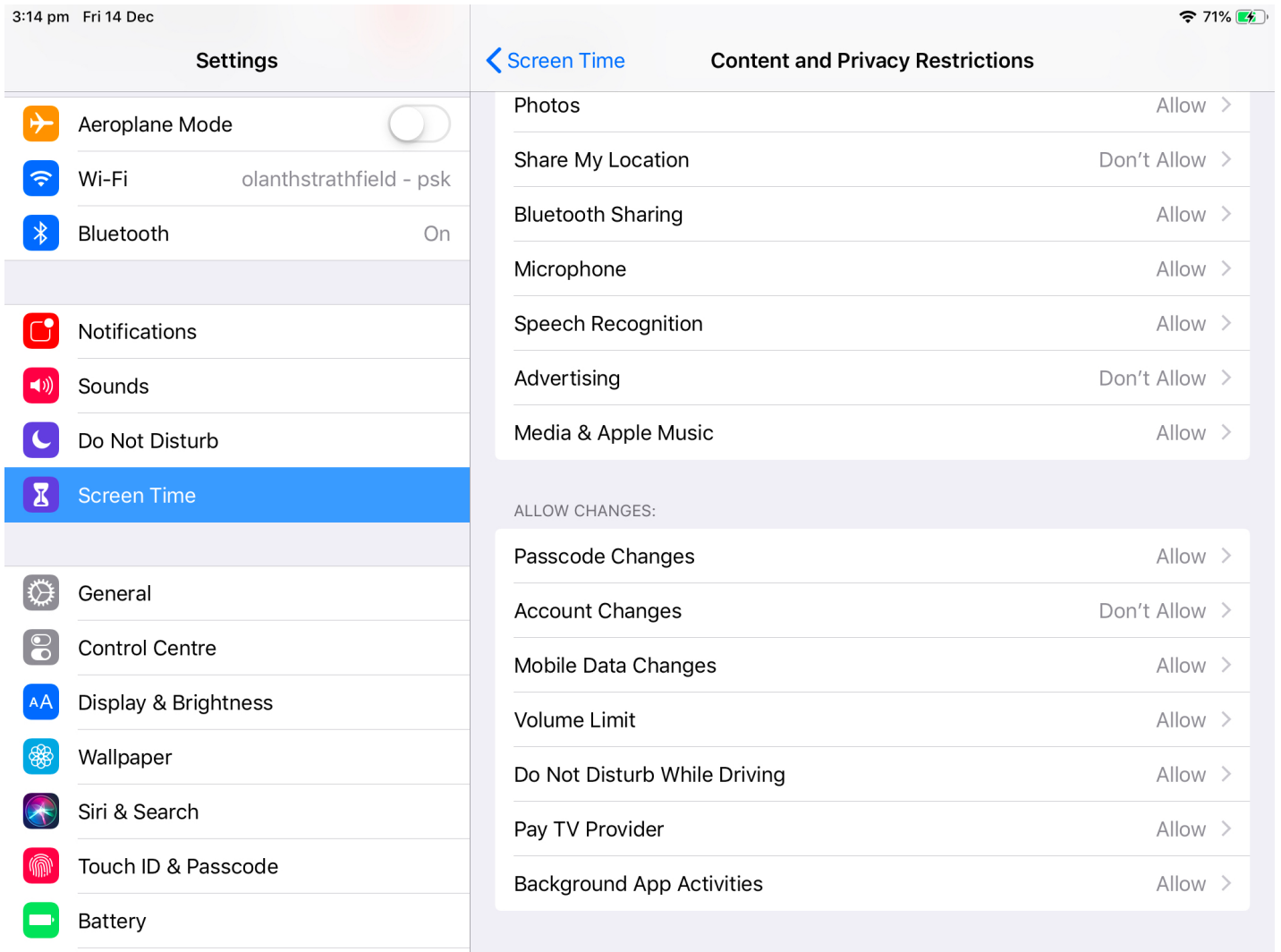
- 1.1. Tap **Accounts**
- 1.2. Tap “Don’t Allow Changes” to set the restriction

2. Background App Activities

- 2.1. Tap **Background App Activities**
- 2.2. Tap “Allow ”
- 2.3. Tap the [< Restrictions](#) link to return to the **ALLOW CHANGES** pane.

3. Volume Limit

- 3.1. Tap **Volume Limit**
- 3.2. Tap “Allow Changes”



Games Center

Staying in the **Restrictions** area, Tap **Content Restrictions** the last pane is the **GAME CENTER** pane.
