

Level V Theatre: Advanced Production

Class Description:

This advanced production class will focus on putting on various productions throughout the year, including a fall production, the Winter Arts Spectacular, and a spring production. Students will participate in productions through performing, assistant directing, and stage managing. Students in this level will be required to participate in mandatory, graded out-of-school rehearsals and performances throughout the year. Students are only admitted to this level through auditions. Only students wishing to put in the extra-curricular effort should audition.

Level IV Theatre: Advanced Acting

Class Description:

This advanced acting class will focus on creating in-depth characterization throughout various scenes, monologues, and class plays throughout the year. Students will also participate in a short scene or play in the end of year spring production. The spring production will have a mandatory, graded after-school rehearsal and performance.

Level III Theatre: Technical Theatre

Class Description:

This technical theatre class focuses not on performing, but all of the technical aspects of the production that happen behind the scenes. Students will complete projects throughout the year focusing on stage makeup, costume/prop/set design and creation, stage management, as well as assisting with various production projects. Students in this level will be required to participate in mandatory, graded after-school rehearsals and performances for the fall and spring productions.

Level II Theatre: Intro to Acting

Class Description:

This acting class will focus on creating characterization and developing performance skills. Students will perform various short poems, monologues, scenes, and in-class plays throughout the year. Students will participate in two in-class plays that will be open to the parents; one Christmas performance, and one in the spring.

Level I Theatre: Intro to Theatre Arts

Class Description:

This introductory level theatre class is designed to immerse students in theatre terminology, etiquette, and basic performance techniques. Students will also study the origins of theatre and participate in an in-class play open to the parents in the spring semester.
