

Home Fixtures:

KWA Spectators are welcome to attend any home fixture that is based on the school field after-school. However, any fixture that starts within school hours (8.30-3.00pm), cannot be watched by spectators due to safeguarding.

Where a home fixture starts outside of school hours spectators will be informed, via the fixture letter, of the sign-in period (10 minute slot). Spectators must read the declaration and then if in agreement complete the sign-in form. Spectators do not need to sign-in at reception. Spectators will then be escorted to pitch by a KWA member of staff. Any spectator that arrives after the sign-in period, will not be allowed on site.

Away Fixtures:

Hull Active Schools: To ensure consistency across the city Hull Active Schools, the city wide partnership who arrange the fixtures for all sports across Hull, have applied some non-mitigating measures across all fixtures for all schools. This includes: "Inter-school fixtures are observed by "home" spectators only. This should allow the host schools to provide a safe and controlled environment for students to play."

Regulations for use by players:

- NO metal studs to be worn on this surface moulded rubber studs or trainers only;
- NO smoking or vaping;
- NO food;
- NO chewing gum;
- NO swinging on goal posts;
- NO sharp or heavy objects on the surface;
- NO glass bottles;
- DO use clean footwear;
- DO put litter in bins provided.

Regulations for school spectators:

- NO smoking or vaping;
- NO food;
- NO foul or explicit language;
- NO photographs to be taken (not all students will have parental/carer permission);
- NO entry onto site if you are not wanting to stay for the full duration of the competition;
- DO ensure you have used any toilet facilities before entering site, as this will not be available for your stay;
- DO ensure you wear suitable footwear;
- DO ensure you sign in with a member of staff;
- DO ensure you stay with the member of staff at the competition area;
- DO ensure you leave site with the staff member escorting you at the end of the fixture (you will not be able to leave before this period);
- DO ensure you support your team with encouragement and praise.
