

Zoe Billingham: Zoë is the Director of IPPR North, the think tank dedicated to developing, progressive ideas to strengthen England's regions. Previously Zoë worked as a civil servant for the UK government holding posts in HM Treasury and the Cabinet Office as economic policy adviser to the Deputy Prime Minister during the coalition government. Zoë has also led the Centre for Progressive Policy think tank and has worked in finance. Zoë regularly appears as a policy commentator on broadcast media and featured on Channel 4 News, BBC, Today Programme, LBC and Sky News. She has written for numerous online and print outlets. Alongside her role at IPPR North, Zoë is a UK2070 Commissioner, a highly successful collaboration involving several Universities including Sheffield. She also became a Fellow of the Academy of Social Sciences in 2024 for her contribution to public policy research and debate. Zoë held a Professor ADH Crook Public Service Fellowship at the University in 2020 and was part of a cohort whose work contributed to the UK2070 Commission. Zoë's Fellowship project explored the accountability of mayoral combined authorities.
